

**NOTICE OF ELECTION**  
**SANITARY & IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (SID) NO. 29**  
**SPECIAL TAX ELECTION**

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 2013, in Sanitary and Improvement District No. 29, Sarpy County, Nebraska, a special election will be held. Said election will be held for the resident and nonresident property owners of property within Sanitary and Improvement District No. 29, Sarpy County, Nebraska, who will approve or reject the following proposition:

**PROPOSITION**

“SID 29 of Sarpy County, Nebraska proposes to request an increase in the total anticipated receipts from property taxes levied on its behalf for its General Fund (an increase of \$9,252.56 or 200%) over the maximum allowable tax permitted by Neb. Rev. Stat. §13-519 for its General Fund for the 2013-2014 fiscal year.

Shall SID 29 of Sarpy County, Nebraska be allowed to increase the total anticipated receipts from property taxes levied on behalf of its General Fund of \$9,252.56 or 200% which is over the maximum allowable tax permitted by Neb. Rev. Stat. §13-519 until fiscal year 2018-2019 for the purpose of general operations, including trash removal?

A vote FOR the proposal will allow SID 29 of Sarpy County, Nebraska to begin trash collection services for the residents of SID 29 of Sarpy County, Nebraska and allow an increase in the total anticipated receipts from property taxes levied for its general fund by \$9,252.56 (200%) over the maximum allowable tax for the general fund.

A vote AGAINST the proposal will limit SID 29 of Sarpy County, Nebraska to the increase permitted by Neb. Rev. Stat. §13-519(1), which would result in the inability to begin trash collection for the residents of SID 29.”

Barb,

Attached are the documents for Sunday's meeting in case you do not receive the originals in the mail tomorrow. You and Mr. O'Neal will need to sign the Certificate, Minutes and warrant as usual. All Trustees will need to sign the Acknowledgement attached to the Minutes. You will also need to sign the separate Certificate with regard to the proposed Special Election. The other documents are simply for your records and to share with the Board.

Per our conversations, the \$9,252.56 that the Board is approving is the maximum extent the budget could increase over the previous general fund amount of \$4,235.00. The accountant wanted to provide a "cushion" for the District in the event, and for whatever reason, trash hauling expenses increased beyond what initially contracted for. In September when the District approves its budget, the Board is not required to levy the total amount approved at this meeting, the Board can simply budget for funds required for the cost of maintenance for the District, which based on last year would be the \$4,235 plus the amount for the trash contract (proposal you were provided \$5,184) plus the additional accounting and legal fees. However, if other maintenance issues would come up in the next couple years, the District would be able to meet those expenses as well. Keep in mind this special election will allow the District to exceed to budget limitations for the next five (5) years.

I hope this provides the Board with adequate information to proceed on this matter. If any questions or issues should arise at the meeting, please feel free to call Pat at (402) 212-2131.

Once you have the documents signed, please get the originals to our office so I can get them to the Election Commissioner and coordinate getting the required mailings completed.
