The undersigned hereby certify that they are the Chairperson and Clerk of Sanitary and Improvement District Number 48 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, (the "District") and hereby further certify as follows:

1. Annexed to this certificate is a true and correct transcript of the proceedings of the Board of Trustees of the District relating to a meeting of said District held on the date and at the time reflected in the meeting minutes contained in said foregoing transcript (the "Meeting"). All of the proceedings of the District and of the Board of Trustees thereof which are set out in the annexed and foregoing transcript have been fully recorded in the journal of proceedings of the District and the undersigned District Clerk has carefully compared the annexed and foregoing transcript with said journal and with the records and files of the District which are in such Clerk's official custody and said transcript is a full, true and complete copy of said journal, records and files which are set out therein.

Notice was given in advance thereof by publication in the Papillion Times, the designated method for giving notice on July 16, 2009 and July 23, 2009, a copy of the proof of publication being attached to these minutes, as well as by posting in three conspicuous places within the District, a copy of the certificate of posting being attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board of Trustees, and a copy of their acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice and in the notice of the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Clerk publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The Chairperson advised that the first order of business was to move for the adoption of the Resolution of Necessity in connection with the resurfacing of Sapp Bros. Drive within the District, which was proposed at the meeting of the Board of Trustees held on July 13, 2009.

The Clerk advised that the following written objections were received from the following persons appearing in person or by their attorney to object to the adoption of the Resolution of Necessity: None.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 48 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that both they and the district hereby find and determine and covenant, warrant and agree as follows: the improvements and/or facilities being financed or refinanced by the above Warrants are for essential governmental functions and are designed to serve members of the general public on an equal basis; all said improvements have from the time of their first acquisition and construction been owned, are owned and are to be owned by the District or another political subdivision; to the extent special assessments have been or are to be levied for any of said improvements, such special assessments have been or are to be levied under Nebraska law as a matter of general application to all property specially benefited by said improvements in the District; the development of the land in the District is for residential or commercial use and the development of the land in the District for sale and occupation by the general public has proceeded and is proceeding with reasonable speed; other than any incidental use of said improvements by a developer during the initial period of development of said improvements, there have been, are and will be no persons with rights to use such improvements other than as members of the general public; none of the proceeds of said Bonds or any refinanced indebtedness have been or will be loaned to any private person or entity; the District hereby authorizes and directs the Chairperson or Clerk to file or cause to be filed, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149(e) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, pertaining to the above Warrants; and the District does not reasonably expect to sell or otherwise dispose of said improvements and/or facilities, in whole or in part, prior to the last maturity of the above Warrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 48 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the District hereby covenants, warrants and

agrees as follows: (a) to take all actions necessary under current federal law to maintain the tax-exempt status (as to taxpayers generally) of interest in the above warrants; and (b) to the extent that it may lawfully do so, the District hereby designates the above warrants as its "qualified tax-exempt obligations" under Section 265 (b) (3) (B) (i) (III) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended and covenants and warrants that the District does not reasonably expect to issue warrants or bonds or other obligations aggregating in the principal amount of more than \$5,000,000 during the calendar year in which the above warrants are to be issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 48 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that this and the preceding resolutions are hereby adopted as the Certificate With Respect to Arbitrage of the District pertaining to the above warrants and the District and the Chairman and Clerk of the District hereby further certify, as of the date of the registration of the above warrants with the County Treasurer of Dodge County, Nebraska, as follows:

1. No separate reserve or replacement fund has been or will be established with respect to the above warrants. The District reasonably anticipates that monies in its Bond Fund reasonably attributable to the above warrants in excess of the lessor of: (a) 10% of the net principal proceeds of the above warrants, (b) the maximum annual debt service due on the above warrants or (c) 125% of annual debt service due on the above warrants will be expended for payment of principal or an interest on the above warrants within thirteen months after receipt of such monies. That amount which is currently held in the District's Bond Fund which exceeds the amount which is to be expended for payment of principal and interest on the above warrants within thirteen months after receipt of such monies, plus that amount arrived at pursuant to the immediately preceding sentence, will not be invested in any securities or any other investment obligations which bear a yield, as computed in accordance with the actuarial method, in excess of the yield on the above warrants.

2. To the best of their knowledge, information and belief, the above expectations are reasonable.

3. The District has not been notified of any listing of it by the Internal Revenue Service as an issuer that may not certify its bonds.

4. The Certificate is being passed, executed and delivered pursuant to Sections 1.148-2(b)(2) of the Income Tax Regulations under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
