



Notice was given in advance thereof by publication in The Papillion Times, the designated method for giving notice on July 6, 2016, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board of Trustees, and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the posted notice to the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. The agenda was at all times available at the office for the District at 1246 Golden Gate Drive, Suite 1, Papillion, Nebraska.

The Chairperson then publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The Clerk then advised the Board that he was in receipt of the Agreements with O'Donnell, Ficenec, Wills & Ferdig, LLP for the budget and audit preparation for the District for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016. After some discussion, Trustee William Dillon introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary & Improvement District No. 79 of Sarpy County, that the Chairperson and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the necessary agreements with O'Donnell, Ficenec, Wills and Ferdig, LLP for the budget and audit preparation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 for the District.

Motion seconded by Trustee Shawn Brechbill. On roll call, the following voted for the passage and adoption of said resolution:

The Clerk then advised the Board that he had been notified by the District's engineer that they would no longer be able to handle engineering matters for the District. A discussion was had with options the District has for retaining a new engineer. After some discussion, the Board decided that it would ask for proposals from various engineering firms that handle other SIDs in the area and consider them for approval at the next meeting.

The Clerk then presented the following statements and recommended the issuance of general fund warrants in payment thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 79 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the Chairperson and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver Warrant Nos. **G-16-995 through G-16-999** to be drawn on the General Fund of the District, dated the date of this meeting, to the following payees in the following amounts, said warrants to draw interest at the rate of Seven percent (7 %) per annum (interest to be payable in February of each year) and to be redeemed no later than July 13, 2019, subject to extension of said maturity date by order of the District Court of Sarpy County, Nebraska, after notice is given as required by law, to-wit:

- Warrant No. G-16-995 for \$11.07 payable to Omaha World-Herald Media Group**
- Warrant No. G-16-996 for \$4.14 payable to One Call Concepts, Inc.**
- Warrant No. G-16-997 for \$300.00 payable to Anytime Tree Service**
- Warrant No. G-16-998 for \$775.00 payable to Clean Sweep Commercial Inc. Parking Lot Services**
- Warrant No. G-16-999 for \$300.00 payable to United Engineering, Inc.**

Thereupon, the Chairperson declared said motion carried and said resolution passed and adopted.

Mark Nelson made the following resolutions and moved their adoption:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 79 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that both they and the District hereby find and determine and covenant, and warrants and agree that (a) the facilities for which the above warrants are issued are designed to serve members of the general public on an

equal basis; (b) there are no persons with rights to use said facilities other than as members of the general public; (c) ownership and operation of said facilities is with the District or another political subdivision; (d) none of the proceeds of the warrants will be loaned to any person and to the extent that special assessments have been or are to be levied for any said facilities, such special assessments have been or are to be levied under Nebraska law as a matter of general application to all property specially benefited by such facilities in the District; (e) the development of the land in the District for sale and occupation by the general public authorizes and directs the Chairman or Clerk to file, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149 (e) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 pertaining to the above warrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 79 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the District hereby covenants, warrants and agrees as follows: (a) to take all actions necessary under current federal law to maintain the tax-exempt status (as to taxpayers generally) of interest in the above warrants that are a charge against the construction account of the District; and (b) to the extent that it may lawfully do so, the District hereby designates the above warrants, that are a charge against the construction account of the District, as its "qualified tax-exempt obligations" under Section 265 (b) (3) (B) (i) (III) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended and covenants and warrants that the District does not reasonably expect to issue warrants or bonds or other obligations aggregating in the principal amount of more than \$10,000,000 during the calendar year in which the above warrants are to be issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 79 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that this and the preceding resolutions are hereby adopted as the Certificate With Respect to Arbitrage of the District pertaining to the above warrants and the District and the Chairman and Clerk of the District hereby further certify, as of the date of the registration of the above warrants with the County Treasurer of Sarpy County, Nebraska, as follows:

1. No separate reserve or replacement fund has been or will be established with respect to the above warrants. The District reasonably anticipates that monies in its Bond Fund reasonably attributable to the above warrants in excess of the lesser of: (a) 10% of the net principal proceeds of the above warrants, (b) the maximum annual debt service due on the above warrants or (c) 125% of annual debt service due on the above warrants will be expended for payment of principal or interest on the above warrants within thirteen months after receipt of such monies. That amount which is currently held in the District's Bond Fund which exceeds the amount which is to be expended for payment of principal and interest on the above warrants within thirteen months after receipt of such monies, plus that amount arrived at pursuant to the immediately preceding sentence, will not be invested in any securities or any other investment obligations which bear a yield, as computed in accordance with the actuarial method, in excess of the yield on the above warrants.

2. To the best of their knowledge, information and belief, the above expectations are reasonable.

3. The District has not been notified of any listing of it by the Internal Revenue Service as an issuer that may not certify its bonds.

4. The Certificate is being passed, executed and delivered pursuant to Sections 1.148-2(b)(2) of the Income Tax Regulations under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
