



**Minutes of Meeting of Board of Trustees
March 16, 2009**

A meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 81 of Sarpy County, Nebraska was held on March 16, 2009, at 7:00 o'clock p.m. at Springfield Memorial Library, 665 Main St., Springfield, Nebraska.

Present were: Chairman David Kelly, Clerk Joseph Volpert and Trustees Renae Kelly, Ken Rudie and Brian Wallman.

Absent: None.

Also present: Engineer Joel Bard, water system operator Gerry Gutoski, Brad Harris of Layne-Western, attorney Larry Forman and two District residents.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Papillion Times on March 12, 2009, and the attorney presented proof of publication of said notice, a copy of said proof of publication being attached to these Minutes. Advance notice was also given to the members of the Board of Trustees and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of such notice is attached to these Minutes. Notice was also given to the County Clerk of Sarpy County, Nebraska per the attached Certificate of the Officers of the District. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice given to the Board of Trustees and to the County Clerk. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Chairman stated that the first item of business on the agenda was compliance with the Nebraska Open Meetings Act. He stated that in compliance with the Act, a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review on the table at which the Board Members were seated.

The Chairman stated that the next item of business on the agenda was approval of the minutes of the meeting of February 16, 2009. After brief discussion, the minutes were approved as submitted.

The Chairman stated that the next item of business on the agenda was resident concerns. No resident concerns were voiced.

The Chairman stated that the next item of business on the agenda was the report of the water well operator. Gerry Gutoski of Providence Group, Inc. stated that we would defer to Brad Harris of Layne-Western for an updated report on the status of the new well. Mr. Harris reported that surging and cleaning of the system has been intensified during the past two weeks during which time a significant amount of material has been removed from the system. The system was recently allowed to sit idle for a period of three days but when a sample was taken at the end of that period, it initially appeared reddish in color. A sample of water taken at that time tested .05ppm for iron, a figure well within acceptable limits. A foot valve has been installed to prevent draw-down prior to restarts, but that has not eliminated the reddish color upon startup, although the discoloration is quite moderate compared to samples taken during prior tests. Once the system starts to run, it tends to run clear with the exception of an occasional rust flake. Mr. Harris stated that he addressed this problem with a chemist who suggested that the Board might consider adding surfactin to the chlorine to see what impact that might have. While it would appear that the discoloration problem continues to emanate from the water column within the system, it appears that the silt problem has been totally resolved. Trustee Renae Kelly inquired about iron bacteria in the water, citing an article she had recently read, but Mr. Harris stated that the iron situation being encountered by SID 81 is a problem in appearance only and does not pose a health issue for system users. He stated that he will reflush the system and coordinate his efforts with Gerry Gutoski, after which he will perform some touch-up painting and perform final grading in the area of the pump house. Mr. Harris again expressed concern about the potential for damage to the pump house from a large volunteer tree on property abutting the Fraser tract. The Trustees directed the attorney to determine ownership of the property in question so that a letter can be sent to the property owner requesting that the tree be taken down before it causes damage to the pump house. After further discussion, Mr. Harris stated that his present plan would call for allowing the system to sit for a couple of days after which it will be reflushed, sampled, chlorinated and repainted where necessary. Gerry Gutoski stated that he is encouraged by progress he has recently observed with regard to the system.

The Chairman stated that the next item of business on the agenda was the engineer's report. Joel Bard reported that the District is on track to have street sweeping performed by K.C. Sweeping during the last half of April.

The Chairman stated that the next item of business on the agenda was the attorney's report. Larry Forman reported as follows:

A. Water quality report. Mr. Forman reported that he has now received from Mr. Gutoski a finalized version of the annual water quality report for 2008 including actions taken by the District to return the system to compliance with the Nebraska Safe Drinking Water Act. A copy of that report will be mailed or emailed to all District water customers in the near future so the certificate of distribution can be complete by Mr. Gutoski and filed with the State prior to July 1, 2009.

B. Apparent problem with emails to Charter subscribers. Mr. Forman stated that the District has recently encountered a problem with Charter email subscribers who are not receiving emails sent from the District. The Trustees suggested that Mr. Forman make sure the emails are being sent to Charter.net rather than Charter.com.

The Chairman stated that the next item of business on the agenda was water system reports.

A. Reports from Gary Shepherd. The Chairman distributed to the Trustees copies of monthly water reports compiled by Gary Shepherd, copies of which are attached to these minutes.

B. Reports from Gerry Gutoski. The Chairman distributed to the Trustees copies of the water production reports compiled by Mr. Gutoski, copies of which are attached to these minutes.

C. Deposits with County Treasurer. The Clerk distributed to the Trustees copies of the County Treasurer's receipt, a copy of which is attached to these minutes, disclosing a deposit in the amount of \$1,657.14 on March 4, 2009 to the District's general fund.

The Chairman stated that the next item of business on the agenda was payment of bills.

He presented the following statements for payment through the District's General Fund:

FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 81 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that both they and the district hereby find and determine and covenant, warrant and agree as follows: the improvements and/or facilities being financed or refinanced by the above Warrants are for essential governmental functions and are designed to serve members of the general public on an equal basis; all said improvements have from the time of their first acquisition and construction been owned, are owned and are to be owned by the District or another political subdivision; to the extent special assessments have been or are to be levied for any of said improvements, such special assessments have been or are to be levied under Nebraska law as a matter of general application to all property specially benefited by said improvements in the District; the development of the land in the District is for residential or commercial use and the development of the land in the District for sale and occupation by the general public has proceeded and is proceeding with reasonable speed other than any incidental use fo said improvements by a developer during the initial period of development of said improvements, there have been, are and will be no persons with rights to use such improvements other than as members of the general public; none of the proceeds of said Bonds or any refinanced indebtedness have been or will be loaned to any private person or entity; the District hereby authorized and directs the Chairperson or Clerk to file or cause to be filed, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149(e) of the Intern Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, pertaining to the above Warrants, and the District does not reasonably expect to sell or otherwise dispose of said improvements and/or facilities, in whole or in part, prior to the last maturity of the above Warrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 81 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the District hereby covenants, warrants and agrees as follows: (a) to take all actions necessary under current federal law to maintain the tax exempt status (as to taxpayers generally) of interest on the above warrants; and (b) to the extent that it may lawfully do so, the District hereby designates the above warrants as its "qualified tax exempt obligation" under Section 265(b)(3)(B)(ii) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended and covenants and warrants that the District does not reasonably expect to issue warrants or bonds or other obligations aggregating in the principal amount of more than \$5,000,000 during the calendar year in which the above warrants are to be issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 81 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that this and the preceding Resolutions are hereby adopted as the Certificate With Respect to Arbitrage of the District pertaining to the above warrants and the District and the Chairman and Clerk of the District hereby further certify, as of the date of the registration of the above warrants with the County Treasurer of Sarpy County, Nebraska as follows:

1. No separate reserve or replacement fund has been or will be established with respect to the above warrants. The District reasonably anticipates that monies in its bond fund reasonably attributable to the above warrants in excess of the lesser of: (a) 10% of the net principal proceeds of the above warrants, (b) the maximum annual debt service due on the above warrants, or (c) 125% of average annual debt service due on the above warrants will be expended for payment of principal of and interest on the above warrants within 13 months after receipt of such monies. That amount which is currently held in the District's bond fund which exceeds the amount which is to be expended for payment of principal and interest on the above warrants within 13 months after receipt of such monies, plus that amount arrived at pursuant to the immediately preceding sentence, will not be invested in any securities or any other investment obligations which bear a yield, as computed in accordance with the actuarial method in excess of the yield on the above warrants.

2. To the best of their knowledge, information and belief, the above expectations are reasonable.

3. The District has not been notified of any listing of it by the Internal Revenue Service as an issuer that may not certify its bonds.

4. The Certificate is being passed, executed and delivered pursuant to Section 1.148-2(b)(2) of the Income Tax Regulations under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS OF SID 81 (Fairview Heights)

Ladies and Gentlemen:

At the February 16 meeting of the Board of Trustees, several items of interest to residents were discussed:

1. Riding of horses on District streets - Riding of horses on District streets is not encouraged principally because of the unsanitary condition created when a mount responds to the call of nature. Please exercise your horses on your ground or outside the boundaries of the subdivision.

2. Barking dogs - Residents are asked to refrain from leaving dogs unattended outside for extended periods of time, especially after 10 p.m. Repeated problems in this regard should be reported to the County Sheriff at 593-2288.

3. Discharge of firearms within the subdivision - The discharging of firearms within or close to the subdivision (or close to any occupied dwelling) is a misdemeanor which could create a serious safety hazard. Please follow the law and report violations to the Sheriff.

4. Thefts and break-ins - Thefts and break-ins involving homes as well as vehicles are on the rise nationwide and Fairview Heights is no exception. Minimize the likelihood of being a victim by keeping vehicles in garages, keeping garage doors closed and locked, and keeping garage door remotes hidden out of sight. Be vigilant and report any incidents or questionable activity to the Sheriff.

5. Landfill odors - Sarpy County has hired Thompson, Dreessen and Dorner, Consulting Engineers, to monitor concerns about odors from the Sarpy County landfill. While the odors do not pose a health hazard, they can be a nuisance. Steps are underway to address the problem. In the meantime, report any problems in this regard to Darin Konda at 330-8860 or dkonda@td2co.com.
