

RE: ELECTION OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES, TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2010

S.I.D. election will be held in the following order:

Deadline for the Notice of Election to be mailed by the Clerk of the District is July 12, 2010, (sixty-five days prior to the election) to each person who is entitled to vote at the election and whose property ownership or lease giving a right to vote is of record. In the notice of election you should give the filing deadline and filing information, and state that a mail-in ballot will be sent and returned to the Election Commissioner.

Filing deadline is July 26, 2010 (fifty days prior to the election). Applications may be obtained from the Election Commissioner's office or online at [www.sarpy.com/forms/](http://www.sarpy.com/forms/) and may be notarized by a Notary Public and returned to the election office by July 26 at 5:00 P.M. Filings are also taken in person at the Election Office. No filing fee is required. When filing, the candidate shall designate on which ballot their name shall appear. The name shall appear on only one ballot. Write-in candidates may be elected to the office, however, the box appearing in front of the write-in name must also be marked. Such trustees shall be owners of real estate located in the district or a designated representative of an entity that owns real estate in the district.

We will secure a list of property owners and labels to be used for the Notice of Election. This listing will be emailed to you approximately the last week of June. After you have completed the mailing and made any corrections to the list, we would appreciate notification of those corrections so they can be used when the ballots are mailed. Please do not send notices to property owners whose addresses are listed at the County Assessor's address, 1210 Golden Gate Dr, Papillion NE, 68046.

We will prepare the ballots and instructions to the voters and mail to each property owner the proper ballot with a return envelope for their use in mailing the ballot back to us. The mail-in ballots will be mailed before, but no later than August 25, 2010 (twenty days prior to election day). They must be returned to us no later than Election Day, September 14, 2010. After that date, we will tally the votes for each District and certify the results of the election to the Clerk and Attorney of the District.

Neb.Rev.Stat.31-735.05 states: The entire costs of conducting the election shall be borne by the S.I.D. holding the election. Within sixty days after the election has been held, we will bill each district. Payment of the entire amount shall be *in currency* (no warrants) and made by the attorney for the S.I.D. to the Election Commissioner within sixty days of receipt of such billing.
