



Notice was given in advance thereof by publication in The Papillion Times, the designated method for giving notice on April 4, 2012, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board of Trustees, and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the posted notice to the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. The agenda was at all times available at the office for the District at 1246 Golden Gate Drive, Suite 1, Papillion, Nebraska.

The Clerk publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The Clerk advised the Board that she had received the Resignation of Patti Papek as trustee for the District. Jill Burns made a motion for the Board to accept said Resignation which was seconded by Randy Randy Burns.

On roll call, the following vote was had: AYE: Randy Burn, Jill Burns, Michael Norris and Kim R. Johnston

The following voted NAY: None.

Thereupon the Chairperson declared the motion carried and said resolution was passed and adopted.

The Clerk then advised that Board that it would be necessary to appoint someone in the District to act as trustee. After some discussion, it was agreed that the Board wouldn't take action until the next meeting, allowing anyone interested in sitting on the Board to come forward.

The Clerk then directed the Board's attention to Agenda Item 3. The initial plans for the west park included park benches that had never been installed, or had been removed for some reason. It had been suggested that the benches be replaced. After some discussion, Jill Burns made the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the Chairperson and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to

purchase and have five (5) park benches installed in the west park pursuant to the initial plans for said park. Randy Burns seconded the motion and on roll call, the following vote was had:

AYE: Randy Burn, Jill Burns, Michael Norris and Kim R. Johnston

The following voted NAY: None.

Thereupon the Chairperson declared the motion carried and said resolution was passed and adopted.

Jill Burns then advised the Board of suggestions made to restore the tennis/basketball courts in the District. After some discussion Jill Burns made the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the Chairperson and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to restore one side of the tennis court in the District that had previously been turned into a basketball court and to resurface the remaining basketball court. Randy Burns seconded the motion and on roll call, the following vote was had:

AYE: Randy Burn, Jill Burns, Michael Norris and Kim R. Johnston

The following voted NAY: None.

Thereupon the Chairperson declared the motion carried and said resolution was passed and adopted.

The Clerk then presented the Board with a letter from the District's engineer with regard to implementing a program for cleaning the sewers of the District in an attempt to limit some of the clogging issues the District has experienced in the past year. After some discussion Jill Burns made the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the Chairperson and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to advise the engineer of the District to implement a program for cleaning the sewers of the District on a rotating basis pursuant to the engineer's letter dated April 2, 2012. Randy Burns seconded the motion and on roll call, the following vote was had:

AYE: Randy Burn, Jill Burns, Michael Norris and Kim R. Johnston

The following voted NAY: None.

Thereupon the Chairperson declared the motion carried and said resolution was passed and adopted.

The next matter to come before the Board was the matter of the property owner at Deborah Circle that had claimed problems with their sidewalk were due to water problems of the District. The Clerk presented the letter provided by the District's engineer specifying that the sidewalk issues at the specific home were not due to sanitary problems of the District, but rather sprinkler system issues of the property. After some discussion Jill Burns made the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the Chairperson and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to request the attorney for the District to send a letter to the property owners advising them of the engineer's findings and requesting the property owners to repair the sidewalks. Randy Burns seconded the motion and on roll call, the following vote was had:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that both they and the district hereby find and determine and covenant, warrant and agree as follows: the improvements and/or facilities being financed or refinanced by the above Warrants are for essential governmental functions and are designed to serve members of the general public on an equal basis; all said improvements have from the time of their first acquisition and construction been owned, are owned and are to be owned by the District or another political subdivision; to the extent special assessments have been or are to be levied for any of said improvements, such special assessments have been or are to be levied under Nebraska law as a matter of general application to all property specially benefited by said improvements in the District; the development of the land in the District is for residential or commercial use and the development of the land in the District for sale and occupation by the general public has proceeded and is proceeding with reasonable speed; other than any incidental use of said improvements by a developer during the initial period of development of said improvements, there have been, are and will be no persons with rights to use such improvements other than as members of the general public; none of the proceeds of said Bonds or any refinanced indebtedness have been or will be loaned to any private person or entity; the District hereby authorizes and directs the Chairperson or Clerk to file or cause to be filed, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149(e) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, pertaining to the above Warrants; and the District does not reasonably expect to sell or otherwise dispose of said improvements and/or facilities, in whole or in part, prior to the last maturity of the above Warrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the District hereby covenants, warrants and agrees as follows: (a) to take all actions necessary under current federal law to maintain the tax-exempt status (as to taxpayers generally) of interest in the above warrants; and (b) to the extent that it may lawfully do so, the District hereby designates the above warrants as its "qualified tax-exempt obligations" under Section 265 (b) (3) (B) (i) (III) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended and covenants and warrants that the District does not reasonably expect to issue warrants or bonds or other obligations aggregating in the principal amount of more than \$5,000,000 during the calendar year in which the above warrants are to be issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that this and the preceding resolutions are hereby adopted as the Certificate With Respect to Arbitrage of the District pertaining to the above warrants and the District and the Chairman and Clerk of the District hereby further certify, as of the date of the registration of the above warrants with the County Treasurer of Sarpy County, Nebraska, as follows:

1. No separate reserve or replacement fund has been or will be established with respect to the above warrants. The District reasonably anticipates that monies in its Bond Fund reasonably attributable to the above warrants in excess of the lessor of: (a) 10% of the net principal proceeds of the above warrants, (b) the maximum annual debt service due on the above warrants or (c) 125% of annual debt service due on the above warrants will be expended for payment of principal of an interest on the above warrants within thirteen months after receipt of such monies. That amount which is currently held in the District's Bond Fund which exceeds the amount which is to be expended for payment of principal and interest on the above warrants within thirteen months after receipt of such monies, plus that amount arrived at pursuant to the immediately preceding sentence, will not be invested in any securities or any other investment obligations which bear a yield, as computed in accordance with the actuarial method, in excess of the yield on the above warrants.

2. To the best of their knowledge, information and belief, the above expectations are reasonable.


3. The District has not been notified of any listing of it by the Internal Revenue Service as an issuer that may not certify its bonds.

4. The Certificate is being passed, executed and delivered pursuant to Sections 1.148-2(b)(2) of the Income Tax Regulations under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.







 **I will be moving out of state and will no longer be able to fulfill my duties to the board.** 



Dear Members of the Board:

In February, a portion of the outfall sanitary sewer line for the southern portion of SID 104 located east of South 132<sup>nd</sup> Street clogged and required an emergency repair. We recommend that the remainder of the line be cleaned this Spring as preventative maintenance.

This line runs through agricultural ground and the manholes are buried to prevent damage to the structures by farm equipment. The estimated cost to dig up the location of the manholes for access to the sewer and to clean the remaining 1,375 feet of sewer is \$1,585.00. This estimated cost, as provide by Utility Services Group, includes an approximate cost of \$190 each to locate the four, buried manholes and \$0.60 per foot to clean the sewer.


In addition to this above recommendation, we recommend that SID 104 begin a program for cleaning a portion of the sanitary sewers within the District annually so that all of the sanitary sewers are cleaned on a four or five year, rotating basis. The cost for this sanitary sewer cleaning, for this year, is also \$0.60 per foot of sewer cleaned.

Last year we met onsite with SID 104 Chairman Randy Burns to review sidewalk and back of curb undermining on the west side of the residence located at 12713 Deborah Circle (on the east side of South 128<sup>th</sup> Street). The Chairman indicated that he understood the undermining had been caused by a sprinkler line that had broken.


In investigating the situation, it was apparent that the undermining of both the sidewalk and the back of curb adjacent to a curb inlet had been from water flowing from the residence previously mentioned and not from the SID infrastructure. The SID should request the property owner repair the undermining, at the property owner's cost, to prevent potential damage to South 128<sup>th</sup> Street.

If the property owner is unwilling to make the repairs, we can arrange for a contractor to do the work with the costs being levied back to the property owner. Please advise us how you wish to proceed.
