



Notice was given in advance thereof by publication in The Times, the designated method for giving notice on September 2, 2015, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board of Trustees, and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice and in the notice to the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Chairperson publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The Clerk then advised the Board that a new developer had contacted the District's attorney with regard to the adjacent property to the District and the necessity to connect to the District's storm sewer. The developer's email was presented to the Board which outlined the plans of the developer and assured the District that any grading would be restored to its original condition. After some discussion, Trustee Kim Johnston introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the attorney for the District be and is hereby authorized and directed to advise Edward Rose Development Company, L.L.C. that the District has no objection to their plans to connect to the District's storm sewer and enter the District's property provided that the District's property is restored and the company and any of its contractors, provide liability insurance including the District as an insured with coverage of no less than \$2M single occurrence/\$4M aggregate.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the Chairperson and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver General Warrant Nos. **4387 - 4393** of the District, dated the date of this meeting, to the following payees in the following amounts, said general warrants to be drawn on the **General Fund** of the District and to draw interest at the rate of Seven percent (7%) per annum (interest to be payable in February of each year) and to be redeemed no later than September 9, 2018, each subject to extension of said maturity date by order of the District Court of Sarpy County, Nebraska, after notice is given as required by law, to-wit:

Thereupon, the Chairman declared the motion carried and said resolution was passed and adopted.

Trustee Jillian Burns then introduced the following resolutions and moved their adoption:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that both they and the district hereby find and determine and covenant, warrant and agree as follows: the improvements and/or facilities being financed or refinanced by the above Warrants are for essential governmental functions and are designed to serve members of the general public on an equal basis; all said improvements have from the time of their first acquisition and construction been owned, are owned and are to be owned by the District or another political subdivision;

to the extent special assessments have been or are to be levied for any of said improvements, such special assessments have been or are to be levied under Nebraska law as a matter of general application to all property specially benefited by said improvements in the District; the development of the land in the District is for residential or commercial use and the development of the land in the District for sale and occupation by the general public has proceeded and is proceeding with reasonable speed; other than any incidental use of said improvements by a developer during the initial period of development of said improvements, there have been, are and will be no persons with rights to use such improvements other than as members of the general public; none of the proceeds of said Bonds or any refinanced indebtedness have been or will be loaned to any private person or entity; the District hereby authorizes and directs the Chairperson or Clerk to file or cause to be filed, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149(e) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, pertaining to the above Warrants; and the District does not reasonably expect to sell or otherwise dispose of said improvements and/or facilities, in whole or in part, prior to the last maturity of the above Warrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the District hereby covenants, warrants and agrees as follows: (a) to take all actions necessary under current federal law to maintain the tax-exempt status (as to taxpayers generally) of interest in the above warrants that are a charge against the construction account of the District; and (b) to the extent that it may lawfully do so, the District hereby designates the above warrants, that are a charge against the construction account of the District, as its "qualified tax-exempt obligations" under Section 265 (b) (3) (B) (i) (III) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended and covenants and warrants that the District does not reasonably expect to issue warrants or bonds or other obligations aggregating in the principal amount of more than \$10,000,000 during the calendar year in which the above warrants are to be issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 104 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that this and the preceding resolutions are hereby adopted as the Certificate With Respect to Arbitrage of the District pertaining to the above warrants and the District and the Chairman and Clerk of the District hereby further certify, as of the date of the registration of the above warrants with the County Treasurer of Sarpy County, Nebraska, as follows:

1. No separate reserve or replacement fund has been or will be established with respect to the above warrants. The District reasonably anticipates that monies in its Bond Fund reasonably attributable to the above warrants in excess of the lessor of: (a) 10% of the net principal proceeds of the above warrants, (b) the maximum annual debt service due on the above warrants or (c) 125% of annual debt service due on the above warrants will be expended for payment of principal of an interest on the above warrants within thirteen months after receipt of such monies. That amount which is currently held in the District's Bond Fund which exceeds the amount which is to be expended for payment of principal and interest on the above warrants within thirteen months after receipt of such monies, plus that amount arrived at pursuant to the immediately preceding sentence, will not be invested in any securities or any other investment obligations which bear a yield, as computed in accordance with the actuarial method, in excess of the yield on the above warrants.

2. To the best of their knowledge, information and belief, the above expectations are reasonable.

3. The District has not been notified of any listing of it by the Internal Revenue Service as an issuer that may not certify its bonds.



Mr. Sullivan:


City of La Vista engineer, Mr. John Kottmann has asked Edward Rose Development to get permission from SID 104 to come on to the property under their jurisdiction for the purpose of connecting to an existing storm sewer out fall pipe. This pipe is currently sending storm water onto our development. We intend to pipe the water across/under our property out to a point where the water ultimately leaves our property. We would be removing an existing flared end section on the SID 104 property and replacing it with a storm sewer structure, then extending the pipe behind one of our proposed buildings. We will need to regrade on the SID 104 property after the installation of the structure. We would also need to take down and then reinstall a section of chain link fencing in order to facilitate this work. All grades would be restored as much as possible to their original condition. Edward Rose Development is requesting written permission from SID 104 to do this work and will hold harmless SID 104 from and against any and all damages, injuries, losses, claims, demands or costs caused by the fault, culpability or negligence of Edward Rose Development or its agents or subcontractors in the installation of the storm line to be extended on the SID 104's property.

I have attached a drawing of the impacted area from our engineering plans for your review and reference.
