

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 147 OF SARPY COUNTY, NE**

A meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 147 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, was convened in open public session at Leonard Lawrence Elementary School, 13204 South 29th Street, Bellevue, Nebraska, at 7:00 p.m. on March 25, 2013. Present were: Richard Scofield, Dennis Whitfield, Shelli Dart and Stacen Gross. Absent was Allen Klostermeyer. Also present was James E. Lang, counsel for the District and Doug Dreessen of Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Bellevue Leader, of Sarpy County, Nebraska on March 20, 2013, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Trustees and a copy of their Acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice of Meeting is attached to these minutes. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The District's attorney publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The Clerk presented to the Board the minutes of the February 25, 2013, District meeting for approval.

After a full discussion, and upon motion being duly made with everyone voting "aye" and no one voting "no", the following Resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, that the minutes of the February 25, 2013, District meeting are hereby approved.

The Clerk then introduced Doug Dreessen, of Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc., to the Board. The first item was to discuss the activities the engineer would be performing for the District. It was agreed that the engineer would be the contact between the District and the various contractors who perform work in the District for the most part, except for smaller maintenance type contractors and maintenance type of work. The engineering company would coordinate and manage the vendor contracts, to a large extent, for the District.

The second item was to discuss the various outstanding 2013 common area maintenance contracts. It was explained that Henry Mowing, who performed the mowing activities would hold their 2012 prices and perform the work during the 2013 maintenance year. Custom Lawns of Omaha would provide the turf care for 2013 at the 2012 prices. The Board directed the District's attorney to document the 2013 maintenance year with those two contractors.

The sprinkler maintenance company which performed the work in 2012, Natures Helper, Inc., was not agreeable to hold their 2012 prices. After discussion, the Board directed the engineer to obtain bids for the operation and maintenance of the sprinkler system and present those to the Board for approval.

The Board discussed the tree maintenance. It was pointed out that Red Hawk had performed tree maintenance in 2012 in which they did not complete their work. After discussion, the Board directed Doug Dreessen to contact Red Hawk to see if they would finish the work and then Doug Dreessen would get proposals from other tree services for future tree maintenance.

Discussion was then held concerning getting a handyman/maintenance person to perform the day to day smaller type park maintenance matters. Doug Dreessen stated that he would provide some names and numbers to the Board.

A discussion was then held concerning the flushing of the sanitary sewers on a periodic basis. Doug Dreessen stated that Omaha flushes their sanitary sewers once every five years by doing approximately 20% each year. The District has not done that, but the District has not had any problems with sanitary sewer backups and there is no indication that there is a sanitary sewage blockage or problem within the District's system. The Board agreed to obtain a bid for the flushing of the sanitary sewers within the District and Doug Dreessen agreed to obtain those bids and provide them to the Board. Once the bid is obtained, the Board can then decide on how to proceed on such matter.

The Board then addressed the Blackhawk Drive Speed Study dated November 19, 2012, which was performed by Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner. Pursuant to the speed study, the speed study shows that the area of 2909 Blackhawk Drive did not meet the warrants for speed control devices. The area of 2613 Blackhawk Drive did meet the warrants for speed control devices and pursuant to their letter, Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner was recommending a 3 way stop at S. 26th Avenue. The pros and cons were discussed relative to such 3 way stop sign at such location. It was pointed that it could impact the residents that are at the location of the 3 way stop, especially in the morning and it may be difficult for them to get out of their driveways. Doug Dreessen stated that they could address the matter by establishing a walkway and adjusting the location of the signs. Doug Dreessen recommended that the Board authorize his firm to move forward with Sarpy County to get the approval for the installation of the stop signs at such location. Once the approvals are obtained by the engineer, the engineer will inform the District and the District can then decide on how to proceed.

After a full discussion, and upon motion being duly made by Richard Scofield, seconded by Stacen Gross, with Richard Scofield, Dennis Whitfield, Shelli Dart and Stacen Gross voting "aye" and no one voting "no", the following Resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the District's engineer to obtain the approval for the 3 way stop sign at S. 26th Avenue, and upon such approval, to submit the same to the Board and the Board can then decide at that time whether or not to proceed with the installation of such stop signs.

Doug Dreessen also stated that the contact with his firm relative to the day to day matters and the management of the vendor contracts would be with Charles Riggs.

The Clerk then presented the following items for consideration by the Board:

After a full discussion, and upon a motion being duly made and seconded, with everyone voting "aye" and no one voting "no", the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Sanitary & Improvement District No. 147 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, hereby approves the above items for payment and hereby authorizes and directs that the following warrants be prepared and issued by the Chairman and Clerk in payment thereof said warrants to bear interest at the rate of 7% per annum after registration and to be charged to the General Fund of the District, to be redeemed no later than March 25, 2016, subject to extension of said maturity date by order of the District Court of Sarpy County, Nebraska after notice is given as required by law, to-wit:

1. WARRANT NO. 1791 in the amount of \$11.07 payable to World Herald Media Group for ad number 1617143-01.
2. WARRANT NO. 1792 in the amount of \$936.86 payable to OPPD for account number 0604100051.
3. WARRANT NO. 1793 in the amount of \$82.07 payable to OPPD for account number 3142100061.
4. WARRANT NO. 1794 in the amount of \$840.00 payable to Crazy Flying W Farms.

5. WARRANT NO. 1795 in the amount of \$3,000.00 and WARRANT NO. 1796 in the amount of \$2,724.89 payable to DWS for a total amount due of \$5,724.89.
6. WARRANT NO. 1797 in the amount of \$2,479.96 payable to Laughlin, Peterson & Lang.

The Clerk then presented the following items for consideration by the Board:

1. Statement from Great Western Bank in the amount of \$250.00.

After full discussion upon motion being duly made and seconded with all Trustees present voting "aye", and with no Trustees voting "no", the following Resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 147 of Sarpy County, Nebraska hereby approves the above items for payment and hereby authorizes and directs that the following warrants be prepared and issued by the Chairman and Clerk in payment thereof, said warrants to bear interest at the rate of 7% per annum after registration and to be charged to the Construction Fund of the District, with the interest to be payable on June 1, 2013, and each year thereafter, and to be redeemed no later than March 25, 2016, subject to extension of said maturity date by order of the District Court of Sarpy County, Nebraska, after notice is given as required by law, to-wit:

1. WARRANT NO. 1798 payable to Great Western Bank in the amount of \$250.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 147 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that both they and the district hereby find and determine and covenant, warrant and agree as follows: the improvements and/or facilities being financed or refinanced by the above Warrants are for essential governmental functions and are designed to serve members of the general public on an equal basis; all said improvements have from the time of their first acquisition and construction been owned, are owned and are to be owned by the District or another political subdivision; to the extent special assessments have been or are to be levied for any of said improvements, such special assessments have been or are to be levied under Nebraska law as a matter of general application to all property specially benefited by said improvements in the District; the development of the land in the District is for residential or

commercial use and the development of the land in the District for sale and occupation by the general public has proceeded and is proceeding with reasonable speed; other than any incidental use of said improvements by a developer during the initial period of development of said improvements, there have been, are and will be no persons with rights to use such improvements other than as members of the general public; none of the proceeds of said Bonds or any refinanced indebtedness have been or will be loaned to any private person or entity; the District hereby authorizes and directs the Chairperson or Clerk to file or cause to be filed, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149(e) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, pertaining to the above Warrants; and the District does not reasonably expect to sell or otherwise dispose of said improvements and/or facilities, in whole or in part, prior to the last maturity of the above Warrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 147 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the District hereby covenants, warrants and agrees as follows: (a) to take all actions necessary under current federal law to maintain the tax exempt status (as to taxpayers generally) of interest on the above Warrants; and (b) to the extent that it may lawfully do so, the District hereby designates the above Warrants as its "qualified tax exempt obligations" under Section 265(b)(3)(B)(i)(III) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended and covenants and warrants that the District does not reasonably expect to issue warrants or bonds or other obligations aggregating in the principal amount of more than \$5,000,000 during the calendar year in which the above Warrants are to be issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 147 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that this and the preceding Resolutions are hereby adopted as the Certificate with Respect to Arbitrage of the District pertaining to the above Warrants and the District and the Chairman and Clerk of the District hereby further certify, as of the date of the registration of the above Warrants with the County Treasurer of Sarpy County, Nebraska, as follows:

1. No separate reserve or replacement fund has been or will be established with respect to the above Warrants. The District reasonably anticipates that monies in its Bond Fund reasonably attributable to the above Warrants in excess of the lesser of: (a)

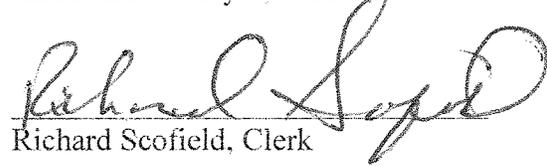
10% of the net principal proceeds of the above Warrants, (b) the maximum annual debt service due on the above Warrants, or (c) 125% of average annual debt service due on the above Warrants will be expended for payment of principal of and interest on the above Warrants within 13 months after receipt of such monies. That amount which is currently held in the District's Bond Fund which exceeds the amount which is to be expended for payment of principal and interest on the above Warrants within 13 months after receipt of such monies, plus that amount arrived at pursuant to the immediately preceding sentence, will not be invested in any securities or any other investment obligations which bear a yield, as computed in accordance with the actuarial method, in excess of the yield on the above Warrants.

2. To the best of their knowledge, information and belief, the above expectations are reasonable.
3. The District has not been notified of any listing of it by the Internal Revenue Service as an issuer that may not certify its bonds.
4. This Certificate is being passed, executed and delivered pursuant to Section 1.148-2(b)(2) of the Income Tax Regulations under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

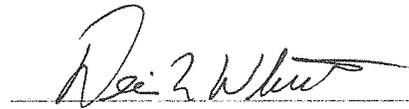
