

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 180 OF SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA HELD AT 5:00 P.M. ON MAY 18, 2016, AT 4512 SHANNON DRIVE, PAPIILLION, NEBRASKA.

The meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 180 of Sarpy County, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 5:00 p.m. May 18, 2016, at NP Dodge, 4912 Shannon Dr., Papillion, Nebraska.

The Chairperson then called the meeting to order and publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where said meeting was held.

Present at the meeting were Trustees Sherry Fletcher, Robert Thomas, David Beberwyk, John Eggertsen, and Jane Embry. Also present was Bill Glismann of HGM Associates, engineers on behalf of the District; Larry Jobeun of Fullenkamp, Doyle & Jobeun, attorneys for the District; J.P. Platisha of Kuehl Capital Corporation, municipal advisor on behalf of the District; No Trustee was absent. Many residents were also present; a sign in sheet was presented so that each person in attendance could be accounted for and made part of the meeting.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Bellevue Leader on May 12, 2016, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Trustees and a copy of their Acknowledgement of Receipt of Notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice and in the notice of the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Clerk then certified that notice of this meeting had been given to the City Clerk of Bellevue, Nebraska at least seven days prior to the time set by the Board of Trustees for this meeting and filed his Certificate to that effect, said Certificate being attached to these minutes and made part hereof by this reference.

The Board then continued its tabled discussion from the April meeting in re: the consolidated trash collection services of the District. HGM and the District's attorney then presented their findings and various examples of other trash collection contracts with multiple servicers in and around the Sarpy County area. The below items were then discussed, in an

open forum setting, by and between the Board, its representatives and various homeowner present at these proceedings:

- i.) Sizes of receptacles made available to the various households;
- ii.) Penalties for residents with trash providers and cancellation of existing services;
- iii.) Contract form – provisions to include, timing of the contract and structure of pick-up dates, etc.
- iv.) Contractors in the area who are preferred and who offer best service.

After the Board completed its conversation in re: the above items, it was then agreed that the District should go to bid on the trash collection services, once a complete review of the proposed contract document(s) had been done by the District and its representatives. Then, upon a motion duly made by the Clerk, seconded by the Chairman, the Board unanimously agreed to have the project go to bid. The engineer then stated they would

The Board then discussed the report from HGM & Associates, engineers on behalf of the District. The following matters were addressed and the following decisions made, related thereto:

- i.) Backyard Drain Improvements – Fountain Drive: contracts were presented and executed;
- ii.) Trail Drainage Improvements: out for bid; bid date of May 24th, 2016;
- iii.) Pavement Repairs – 2016: out for bid; bid date of May 24th, 2016;
- iv.) Retaining wall at trail: 75-80% of design completed; estimated cost for total of improvements is \$92,145.00; second, motion and unanimous consent from Board to begin work in easement area as soon as practicable;
- v.) Miscellaneous.



- We added a subdrain system east of the trail in areas that have displayed saturated soils in the past inspections.

Retaining Wall at Trail



- Developed plans for new retaining wall and trail replacement at The property line is right along the back of the wall so we have used RediRock wall block (large, 46"x18"x40" blocks). This would be a gravity wall without geogrid tie backs so there is less excavation and impact to the neighboring property.
- Also this project would include repairing the bank erosion on the bank of the drainage area across from the retaining wall.
- We will need an easement from the property owner for construction.
- The estimated construction cost is \$92,145. (See attached estimate)



Re: Centralized Waste Disposal for SID 180

Dear Resident,

The undersigned represents SID No. 180 in Sarpy County, the subdivision in which you reside or in which you are the owner of real property. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Board of Trustees intent to consolidate trash and waste disposal service within the District by utilizing the service of a singular company, in conjunction with the recent passing of NE Legislative Bill 324.

Thanks to this change in Nebraska law, SID 180, Lakewood Villages, has the opportunity to provide solid waste removal services to all homes in the subdivision. The service would be covered by the property taxes residents are already paying. Based on the latest figures provided by the SID's financial consultant, the volunteer trustees of the SID 180 board of directors anticipate that no increase to the mill levy would be required to cover the expense, and they would like to begin offering this service July 1.

The service would include garbage, recycling, and yard waste. Bids will be sought from all companies currently providing these services to homeowners within the district.

Moving to one carrier will provide a number of benefits to neighborhood residents:


- 1) No homeowner fees for trash service.
- 2) Trash pickup limited to one day per week, reducing frequency of litter and number of days unsightly carts are at the curb.
- 3) Less wear and tear on the infrastructure of the subdivision, with only one company's trucks using our streets.
- 4) Carts for each service so that litter will not blow out of open bins.

Using the SID-provided waste service would not be mandatory. Should a resident prefer to keep his/her current provider, he/she would be able to continue paying, and receiving service from that company.




