**MINUTES OF MEETING OF SANITARY AND  
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 204 OF  
SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA**



A meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 204 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 2:00 p.m. on November 11, 2004, at 2120 South 72nd Street, Suite 1250, Omaha, Nebraska. Present were: Trustees Herbert D. Beard, Stan Baatz and Roger Lindsey; Absent: None. Also present was Attorney Robert J. Huck.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Papillion Times, Papillion, Nebraska, on November 4, 2004, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was sent to the Sarpy County Clerk, Papillion, Nebraska, not less than seven (7) days prior to the date of this meeting. Notice of this meeting was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Trustees, and a copy of their Acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice and in the notice to the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The undersigned Clerk hereby certifies that these minutes were written and available for public inspection within ten (10) working days after the date of said meeting.

After calling the meeting to order and completion of roll call, the Chairman directed the Board's attention to Agenda Item No. 2, Report on Election of Trustees held on September 14, 2004. The Board had previously been provided with copies of the County Election Commissioner's certificate of election, a copy of which is attached to these minutes. As the certificate reflects, three candidates were elected to serve for the current term, i.e., Roger Lindsey, Herbert D. Beard and Stan M. Baatz. Mr. Huck then reviewed with the Board the duties of trustees in general, and the duties of the Chairman and Clerk in particular, as well as the purposes and powers of a Sanitary and Improvement District. He then reviewed the history of the SID briefly with the newly elected Board.

Mr. Huck then stated that it was necessary for this newly elected Board to elect two officers, viz., a Chairman and a Clerk, and stated that the Board should now entertain nominations for the offices of Chairman and Clerk. Following discussion, Herbert D. Beard was nominated for the office of Chairman, and Stan Baatz was nominated for the office of Clerk. Such nominations being seconded, and there being no further nominations, the following resolution was duly moved and seconded, to-wit:

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 204 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that Herbert D. Beard is elected as Chairman of the District and Stan Baatz is elected as Clerk of the District, to serve until the next election of Trustees or until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

On roll call on the foregoing resolution, the following Trustees voted aye: Herbert D. Beard, Stan Baatz and Roger Lindsey; voting nay thereon were the following Trustees: None. The Chairman then declared said resolution to be duly carried and adopted.

Mr. Huck stated that he would procure the statutory bonds for the Chairman and Clerk and file them with the County Clerk. He also presented for each of the Trustees an Oath of Office, which each member signed. Mr. Huck stated that he would file their Oaths with the County Clerk as well.

The Chairman then directed the Board's attention to Agenda Item No. 3 and informed the Trustees that the previous Board of Trustees had authorized the issuance of Warrants Nos. 494 through 498 on August 31, 2004, but that the warrants had not been returned to Mr. Huck's office for processing and had become lost, and that they were never registered with the Treasurer's office. He stated that it would be appropriate to reissue the warrants, using the same date as originally issued and affixing the letter "A" to the number of each warrant.

WHEREAS, the warrants identified as Nos. 494 through 498, inclusive, dated August 31, 2004, have been lost or misplaced;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 204 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the Chairman and the Clerk be and hereby are authorized and directed to issue replacement Warrants Nos. 494-A through 498-A, dated August 31, 2004, as follows:

GENERAL FUND  
(Due August 31, 2007)

1. Warrant No. 494-A in the sum of \$3,023.20 payable to Omaha Public Power District, in payment of street lights service 3/30/04 through 7/30/04, Account No. 4704100060.
2. Warrant No. 495-A in the sum of \$5,000.00 and Warrant No. 496-A in the sum of \$2,800.00 (total \$7,800.00) payable to Darst & Associates, P.C., in payment of statement dated 8/31/04 for services re 2004-2005 budget and audit for year ended 6/30/04 .
3. Warrant No. 497-A in the sum of \$200.00 payable to Sasha Looch in payment of Invoice No. 1020 for bookkeeping services for year ended 6/30/04.
4. Warrant No. 498-A in the sum of \$4,739.37 payable to Croker, Huck, Kasher, DeWitt, Anderson & Gonderinger, L.L.C. in payment of legal services and costs per statements dated 4/28/04, 5/24/04, 6/14/04,

7/22/04 and 8/17/04, Account Nos. 456-000 and 456-002.

On roll call on the foregoing resolution, the following Trustees voted aye: Herbert D. Beard, Stan Baatz and Roger Lindsey; voting nay thereon were the following Trustees: None. The Chairman then declared said resolution to be duly carried and adopted.

The Chairman then directed the Board's attention to Agenda Item No. 4, Payment of Bills, and presented for the Board's consideration the following bills, statements and invoices. After full review of all statements and complete discussion, the following resolutions were duly moved and seconded, to-wit:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 204 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the Chairman and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver Warrant Nos. 499 and 500 of the District, dated the date of this meeting, to the following payees and in the following amounts, said Warrants Nos. 499 and 500 to be drawn on the General Fund Account of the District and to bear interest at the rate of seven percent (7%) per annum, (interest to be payable on May 1 of each year, as to the Construction Fund Warrants only), and to be redeemed no later than the dates noted below, subject to extension of said maturity date, (for Construction Fund Warrants only), by order of the District Court of Sarpy County, Nebraska, after notice is given as required by law, to-wit:

GENERAL FUND  
(Due November 11, 2007)

1. Warrant No. 499 in the sum of \$1,209.28 payable to Omaha Public Power District, in payment of street lights service 8/30/04 through 10/28/04, Account No. 4704100060.
2. Warrant No. 500 in the sum of \$3,079.54 payable to Croker, Huck, Kasher, DeWitt, Anderson & Gonderinger, L.L.C. in payment of legal services and costs per statements dated 9/20/04 and 10/14/04, Account Nos. 456-000 and 456-002.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 204 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that both they and the District hereby find and determine and covenant, and warrant and agree that (a) the facilities for which the above Warrants are issued are for essential governmental functions and are designed to serve

members of the general public on an equal basis; (b) there are no persons with rights to use said facilities other than as members of the general public; (c) ownership and operation of said facilities is with the District or another political subdivision; (d) none of the proceeds of the Warrants will be loaned to any person and to the extent that special assessments have been or are to be levied for any said facilities, such special assessments have been or are to be levied under Nebraska law as a matter of general application to all property specially benefitted by such facilities in the District; (e) the development of the land in the District is for residential or commercial use; (f) the development of the land in the District for sale and occupation by the general public is proceeding with reasonable speed and (g) the District hereby authorizes and directs the Chairman or Clerk to file, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149(e) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 pertaining to the above Warrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 204 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the District hereby covenants, warrants and agrees as follows: (a) to take all actions necessary under current federal law to maintain the tax exempt status (as to taxpayers generally) of interest on the above Warrants; and (b) to the extent that it may lawfully do so, the District hereby designates the above Warrants as its "qualified tax exempt obligations" under Section 265(b)(3)(B)(i)(III) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and covenants and warrants that the District does not reasonably expect to issue warrants or bonds or other obligations aggregating in the principal amount of more than \$5,000,000 during the calendar year in which the above Warrants are to be issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 204 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that this and the preceding Resolutions are hereby adopted as the Certificate with Respect to Arbitrage of the District pertaining to the above Warrants and the District and the Chairman and Clerk of the District hereby further certify, as of the date of the registration of the above Warrants with the County Treasurer of Sarpy County, Nebraska, as follows:

I. No separate reserve or replacement fund has been or will be established with respect to the above Warrants. The District reasonably anticipates that monies in its Bond Fund reasonably attributable to the above Warrants in excess of the

lesser of: (a) 10% of the net principal proceeds of the above Warrants, (b) the maximum annual debt service due on the above Warrants, or (c) 125% of average annual debt service due on the above Warrants will be expended for payment of principal of and interest on the above Warrants within 13 months after receipt of such monies. That amount which is currently held in the District's Bond Fund which exceeds the amount which is to be expended for payment of principal and interest on the above Warrants within 13 months after receipt of such monies, plus that amount arrived at pursuant to the immediately preceding sentence, will not be invested in any securities or any other investment obligations which bear a yield, as computed in accordance with the actuarial method, in excess of the yield on the above warrants.

2. To the best of their knowledge, information and belief, the above expectations are reasonable.

3. The District has not been notified of any listing of it by the Internal Revenue Service as an issuer that may not certify its bonds.

4. This Certificate is being passed, executed and delivered pursuant to Section 1.148-2(b)(2) of the Income Tax Regulations under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

On roll call on the foregoing resolutions, the following Trustees voted aye: Herbert D. Beard, Stan Baatz and Roger Lindsey; voting nay thereon were the following Trustees: None. The Chairman then declared said resolutions duly carried and adopted.

The Chairman then directed the Board's attention to Agenda Item No. 5, Miscellaneous Matters.

a) The subject of clean-up services for the District was postponed until the spring.

b) The Board reviewed the District's insurance coverages and directed Attorney Huck to obtain officers and directors liability coverage on behalf of the District.

c) Financial matters of the District were discussed, and Mr. Huck was requested to provide copies of certain documents to the Board members.

d) The Board reviewed a representation letter prepared by the District's auditors for the signature of the Chairman. In view of the fact that the previous Chairman was not

available to sign the letter, the Board directed the current Chairman to sign same after he has had a chance to review the materials provided by Attorney Huck.

The Chairman then directed the Board's attention to Agenda Item No. 6 and stated that it would be appropriate for the Board to enter into executive session for a discussion of current and potential litigation. Thereupon, at 3:00 p.m. the following resolution was duly moved and seconded, to-wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 204 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, enter into an executive session for the purpose of discussing matters concerning current and potential litigation.


