The undersigned hereby certify that they are the Chairperson and Clerk of **Sanitary and Improvement District Number 223 of Sarpy County, Nebraska**, (the "District") and hereby further certify as follows:

1. Annexed to this certificate is a true and correct transcript of the proceedings of the Board of Trustees of the District relating to a meeting of said District held on the date and at the time reflected in the meeting minutes contained in said foregoing transcript (the "Meeting"). All of the proceedings of the District and of the Board of Trustees thereof which are set out in the annexed and foregoing transcript have been fully recorded in the journal of proceedings of the District and the undersigned District Clerk has carefully compared the annexed and foregoing transcript with said journal and with the records and files of the District which are in such Clerk's official custody and said transcript is a full, true and complete copy of said journal, records and files which are set out therein.



All of the subjects addressed at the Meeting were contained in the agenda for the Meeting, which agenda was kept continually current and readily available for public inspection at the address listed in the meeting notice for the Meeting and a copy of which is attached to this Certificate; such subjects were contained in said agenda for at least 24 hours prior to the Meeting and each agenda item was sufficiently descriptive to give the public reasonable notice of the matters to be considered at the Meeting.



No litigation is now pending or threatened to restrain or enjoin the District from the issuance and delivery of any warrants or other obligations issued by the District or the levy and collection of tax or other revenues or relating to any of the improvements for which any such warrants or other obligations were or are issued nor in any manner questioning the proceedings and authority under which any such warrants or other obligations were or are issued or affecting the validity thereof; neither the corporate existence or boundaries of the District nor the title of its present officers to their respective offices is being contested; no authority or proceedings for the issuance of any warrants or other obligations by the District have been repealed, revoked or rescinded as of the date hereof. All actions taken by the Board of Trustees referred to in said transcript were taken at a public meeting while open to the attendance of the public.

**MEETING MINUTES
SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 223
OF SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA**

The meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 223 of Sarpy County, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 11:30 a.m. on December 17, 2014, at 11440 West Center Road, Omaha, Nebraska.

Present at the meeting were Trustees Darrel Swenson, Tyler Block, and Steven Kloucek. Absent were Brandon Quetkenhaus and Jodi Brdicko. Also present were John H. Fullenkamp, attorney for the District, Doug Kellner, engineer for the District, and Rob Wood of Kuehl Capital Corporation, financial advisors for the District.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Bellevue Leader on December 3 and 10, 2014, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Trustees and a copy of their Acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice and in the notice to the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Clerk then certified that notice of this meeting had been given to the Sarpy County Clerk at least seven days prior to the time set by the Board of Trustees for this meeting and filed his Certificate to that effect, said Certificate being attached to these minutes and made a part hereof by this reference.

The Chairman publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The Clerk then announced that the last publication of the notice of this meeting was more than five days prior to the time set by the Board of Trustees for public hearing, as set forth in the Proof of Publication. The Clerk further announced that notice had been posted in three conspicuous places within the District and filed his Certificate to that effect, said Certificate being attached to these minutes and made a part hereof by this reference.

The Clerk then stated that no petition opposing the Resolution of Necessity had been filed by any of the property owners within the District nor by any other person and no person appeared at the meeting or made any objections to the proposed Resolution of Necessity.

The Trustees then voted "aye" and passed and adopted the proposed Resolution of Advisability and Necessity, being the same Resolution adopted in form at the meeting of the Board of Trustees held on November 17, 2014, which Resolution is set forth in full in the Proof of Publication attached hereto; the Trustees then passed the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 223 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the Resolution of Necessity for the construction of Sugar Creek Park Improvements be and hereby is approved as proposed at the meeting of the Board of Trustees held on November 17, 2014.

The Chairman then presented the following statements for payment from the General Fund Account of the District:

RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 223 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the Chairman and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver Warrant Nos. 2103 and 2104 of the District, to be dated the date of this meeting, to the following payees, for the following services and in the following amounts, to draw interest at the rate of 7% per annum, to be payable from the General Fund Account of the District and to be redeemed no later than three years from the date hereof, being December 17, 2017, ("the **General Fund Warrants**"), to-wit:

- a) Warrant No. 2103 for \$1,406.51 payable to Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc. for engineering services.
- b) Warrant No. 2104 for \$1,085.00 payable to Montemarano Landscapes, Inc. for park maintenance.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting was adjourned.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 223 of Sarpy County, Nebraska will be held at 11:30 A.M. at the Summer Kitchen Bakery and Cafe, 12010 Giles Road, La Vista, Nebraska on December 17, 2014, which meeting will be open to the public. The agenda for such meeting, kept continuously current, is available for public inspection at 11440 West Center Road, Omaha, Nebraska and includes the payment of bills of the District and the consideration and passing or amending and passing the following Resolution, to-wit:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 223 of Sarpy County, Nebraska find and determine that it is advisable and necessary for the District to construct the Sugar Creek Park Improvements on property located within and owned by the District. Said Improvements shall be constructed as follows:

SUGAR CREEK PARK IMPROVEMENTS: Construct a 6" concrete tennis court complete with surfacing, striping, net and fence. Construct 4" thick concrete basketball court. Install basketball backboards and posts and stripe basketball court. Construct 4" thick concrete pad for shelter location, construct 4" thick sidewalk for playground area, move sand volleyball location, and any associated earthwork, erosion control measures, and seeding necessary to provide a complete installation in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by Thompson, Dreessen and Dornier for this project.

Said Improvement shall be located within Outlot "A", Sugar Creek Replat 3 and Outlot "A", Sugar Creek Addition, which is owned by the District. The tennis court shall be located approximately 200 feet north and 70 east of the eastern-most corner of Lot 38. The volleyball court shall be located approximately 195 feet north and 12 east of the eastern-most corner of Lot 35, and the playground area shall be located approximately 65 feet north of the northeast corner of Lot 3. The shelter location shall be located approximately 160 feet north and 50 east of the northeast corner of Lot 1.

The outer boundaries of the areas which may become subject to special assessment for said improvement are pro-

posed to be the same as the outer boundaries of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 223 of Sarpy County, Nebraska.

Plans and Specifications for said improvement have been prepared by Thompson, Dreessen & Dornier, engineers for the District and said engineers have filed with the Clerk of the District prior to the first publication of this Resolution, an estimate of the total costs of said improvement, including engineering fees, legal fees, fiscal fees, interest and other miscellaneous costs, which estimate is in the sum of \$284,200.00.

To pay the cost of said improvement the Board of Trustees shall have the power to issue negotiable bonds of the District after such improvements have been completed and accepted, said bonds to be called "Sanitary and Improvement District Bonds" and shall be payable and bear interest as provided by the Statutes of the State of Nebraska.

The Board of Trustees shall assess to the extent of special benefits the cost of such improvements upon properties specially benefited thereby. All special assessments which may be levied upon the properties specially benefited by such improvements shall, when collected, be set aside and constitute a sinking fund for the payment of interest and principal of said bonds. The District shall also cause to be

District except intangible property, which together with said sinking fund derived from special assessments shall be sufficient to meet payment of the interest and principal of said bonds as the same become due, said tax shall be known as the Sanitary and Improvement District Tax and shall be payable annually in money.

If a petition opposing this Resolution, signed by property owners representing a majority of the front footage which may become subject to assessment for the cost of the improvements as set forth herein, is filed with the Clerk of the District within three (3) days before the date of the hearing on this Resolution, this Resolution shall not be passed.






