1. Annexed to this certificate is a true and correct transcript of the proceedings of the Board of Trustees of the District relating to a meeting of said District held on the date and at the time reflected in the meeting minutes contained in said foregoing transcript (the "Meeting"). All of the proceedings of the District and of the Board of Trustees thereof which are set out in the annexed and foregoing transcript have been fully recorded in the journal of proceedings of the District and the undersigned District Clerk has carefully compared the annexed and foregoing transcript with said journal and with the records and files of the District which are in such Clerk's official custody and said transcript is a full, true and complete copy of said journal, records and files which are set out therein.

2. Advance notice for the Meeting was given by publication as set forth in the affidavit of publication contained in the foregoing transcript and was mailed to the Clerk of the municipality or county within whose zoning jurisdiction the District is located at least seven days prior to the date of the Meeting. Advance notice for the Meeting, including notice of agenda subjects, was given to all members of the Board of Trustees. All news media requesting notification of meetings of said body were provided with advance notice of the times and places of such meetings and the subjects to be discussed.

3. All of the subjects addressed at the Meeting were contained in the agenda for the Meeting, which agenda was kept continually current and readily available for public inspection at the address listed in the meeting notice for the Meeting and a copy of which is attached to this Certificate; such subjects were contained in said agenda for at least 24 hours prior to the Meeting and each agenda item was sufficiently descriptive to give the public reasonable notice of the matters to be considered at the Meeting.



No litigation is now pending or threatened to restrain or enjoin the District from the issuance and delivery of any warrants or other obligations issued by the District or the levy and collection of tax or other revenues or relating to any of the improvements for which any such warrants or other obligations were or are issued nor in any manner questioning the proceedings and authority under which any such warrants or other obligations were or are issued or affecting the validity thereof; neither the corporate existence or boundaries of the District nor the title of its present officers to their respective offices is being contested; no authority or proceedings for the issuance of any warrants or other obligations by the District have been repealed, revoked or rescinded as of the date hereof. All actions taken by the Board of Trustees referred to in said transcript were taken at a public meeting while open to the attendance of the public.

**MEETING MINUTES  
SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 225  
OF SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA**

The meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 225 of Sarpy County, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 9 A.M. on April 11, 2014 at 11440 West Center Road, Omaha, Nebraska.

Present at the meeting were Trustees Brian Webber, Thomas Haynes, and Matt Rickert. Absent was Jeff Holl. Also present was Brian C. Doyle, attorney for the District.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Bellevue Leader on April 9, 2014, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Trustees and a copy of their Acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice and in the notice to the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Clerk then certified that notice of this meeting had been given to the Sarpy County Clerk at least seven days prior to the time set by the Board of Trustees for this meeting and filed his Certificate to that effect, said Certificate being attached to these minutes and made a part hereof by this reference.

The Chairman publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The attorney for the District then presented the Certification of Election Results reflecting that Brian Webber, Thomas Haynes, Jeffrey Holl and Matt Rickert had been elected as Trustees of the District to serve until the next election in accordance with the law. Discussion was then had concerning appointing a Chairman and Clerk of the District, whereupon, a motion was duly made, seconded and unanimously adopted appointing Brian Webber as Chairman and Thomas Haynes as Clerk of the District. The Clerk was then directed to file bonds for the Chairman and Clerk in the respective amounts of \$5,000 and \$20,000 with the Sarpy County Clerk, and to attach a copy of the election results to these minutes.

The Chairman then presented the following statements for payment from the General Fund Account of the District:

a) Omaha Public Power District for street lighting (Account No. 92644113870).	\$7,848.73
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- b) E & A Consulting Group for engineering services  
(#122162, 122357, 122666, 122996, 123316,  
123629, 123918). 6,615.58
- c) Utilities Service Group for televising sewer (#10051). 350.00
- d) Stanek Construction Company for stop sign (#13-020). 145.00

The Chairman then advised that there is now due and owing Kuehl Capital Corporation the sum of \$373.99 in warrants at this time, payable from the General Fund Account of the District, which amount represents 2.5% of the principal amount of General Fund warrants issued at this meeting (\$14,959.31) in connection with transaction related services and/or private placement services for the District.

The Chairman further advised that there is now due and owing First National Capital Markets, Inc. the sum of \$306.67 in warrants at this time, payable from the General Fund Account of the District, which amount represents 2.0% of the principal amount of General Fund warrants issued at this meeting (\$15,333.30) for the purchase of said warrants.

Then, upon a motion duly made, seconded and upon a roll call vote of "aye" by the Trustees, the following resolutions were adopted:

RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 225 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the Chairman and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver Warrant Nos. 1019 through 1028, inclusive, of the District, to be dated the date of this meeting, to the following payees, for the following services and in the following amounts, to draw interest at the rate of 7% per annum, to be payable from the General Fund Account of the District and to be redeemed no later than three years from the date hereof, being April 11, 2017, to-wit:

- a) Warrant Nos. 1019 and 1020 each for \$3,000.00 and Warrant No. 1021 for \$1,848.73 all payable to the Omaha Public Power District for street lighting.
- b) Warrant Nos. 1022 and 1023 each for \$3,000.00 and Warrant No. 1024 for \$615.58 all payable to E & A Consulting Group for engineering services.
- c) Warrant No. 1025 for \$350.00 payable to Utilities Service Group for sewer televising.
- d) Warrant No. 1026 for \$145.00 payable to Stanek Construction Company for stop sign.

e) Warrant No. 1027 for \$373.99 payable to Kuehl Capital Corporation in connection with the issuance of Warrant Nos. 1019-1026.

f) Warrant No. 1028 for \$306.67 payable to First National Capital Markets, Inc. in connection with the purchase of Warrant Nos. 1019-1027.

FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 225 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that both they and the district hereby find and determine and covenant, warrant and agree as follows: the improvements and/or facilities being financed or refinanced by the above Warrants are for essential governmental functions and are designed to serve members of the general public on an equal basis; all said improvements have from the time of their first acquisition and construction been owned, are owned and are to be owned by the District or another political subdivision; to the extent special assessments have been or are to be levied for any of said improvements, such special assessments have been or are to be levied under Nebraska law as a matter of general application to all property specially benefited by said improvements in the District; the development of the land in the District is for residential or commercial use and the development of the land in the District for sale and occupation by the general public has proceeded and is proceeding with reasonable speed; other than any incidental use of said improvements by a developer during the initial period of development of said improvements, there have been, are and will be no persons with rights to use such improvements other than as members of the general public; none of the proceeds of said Bonds or any refinanced indebtedness have been or will be loaned to any private person or entity; the District hereby authorizes and directs the Chairperson or Clerk to file or cause to be filed, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149(e) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, pertaining to the above Warrants; and the District does not reasonably expect to sell or otherwise dispose of said improvements and/or facilities, in whole or in part, prior to the last maturity of the above Warrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 225 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the District hereby covenants, warrants and agrees as follows: (a) to take all actions necessary under current federal law to maintain the tax exempt status (as to taxpayers generally) of interest on the above Warrants; and (b) to the extent that it may lawfully do so, the District hereby designates the above Warrants as its "qualified tax exempt obligations" under Section 265(b)(3)(B)(i)(III) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended and covenants and warrants that the District does not reasonable expect to issue warrants or bonds or other obligations aggregating in the principal amount of more than \$5,000,000 during the calendar year in which the above Warrants are to be issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 225 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that this and the preceding Resolutions are hereby adopted as the Certificate with Respect to Arbitrage of the District pertaining to the above Warrants and the District and the Chairman and Clerk of the District hereby further certify, as of the date of the registration of the above Warrants with the County of Sarpy County, Nebraska, as follows:

1. 1. No separate reserve or replacement fund has been or will be established with respect to the above Warrants. The District reasonably anticipates that monies in its Bond Fund reasonably attributable to the above Warrants in excess of the less of: (a) 10% of the net principal proceeds of the above Warrants, (b) the maximum annual debt service due on the above Warrants, or (c) 125% of average annual debt service due on the above Warrants will be expended for payment of principal of and interest on the above Warrants within 13 months after receipt of such monies. That amount which is currently held in the District's Bond Fund which exceeds the amount which is to be expended for payment of principal and interest on the above Warrants within 13 months after receipt of such monies, plus that amount arrived at pursuant to the immediately preceding sentence, will not be invested in any securities or any other investment obligations which bear a yield, as computed in accordance with the actuarial method, in excess of the yield on the above Warrants.


2. To the best of their knowledge, information and belief, the above exceptions are reasonable.

3. The District has not been notified of any listing of it by the Internal Revenue Service as an issuer that may not certify its Bonds.




The City's tort claim against S.I.D. No. 225 is on account of damage to and the loss of property caused by the negligent and wrongful acts and omissions of the employees, officers, and members of the governing body of S.I.D. No. 225, consisting of, but not limited to, the negligent and wrongful interference with the City's rights and use of a recorded permanent sanitary sewer easement within S.I.D. No. 225, the negligent and wrongful failure to protect, inspect, maintain, and repair the real and personal property and infrastructure of S.I.D. No. 225, the negligent and wrongful failure to protect, inspect, maintain, and repair lateral support for the City's permanent sanitary sewer easement, the negligent and wrongful failure to protect, inspect, maintain, and repair Outlot "A" of S.I.D. No. 225, the negligent and wrongful failure to protect, inspect, maintain, and repair S.I.D. No. 225's stormwater pipe and infrastructure located on Lot 50 and Outlot "A", and the negligent and wrongful failure to properly remove the drainage pipe from a detention cell on said Lot 50 and/or Outlot "A" before constructing said stormwater pipe.

As a direct and proximate cause of said negligent and wrongful acts and omissions the City incurred in September 2013 damages and loss of property consisting of, but not limited to, interference with the City's rights and use of said recorded permanent sanitary sewer easement within said Outlot "A", relocation of said easement, obtaining new permanent sanitary sewer easement areas, obtaining temporary construction easements, abandonment of portions of the City sanitary sewer mains, and relocation of the City's sanitary sewer mains. The City's resulting damages and losses consist of, but are not limited to, \$164,952.60 total project cost, \$2,250.00 appraiser fees, attorney fees not yet calculated, and miscellaneous costs, expenses, damages, and losses not yet calculated.

Pursuant to the Nebraska Political Subdivisions Tort Claims Act, S.I.D. No. 225 is respectfully requested to exercise its authority and consider, ascertain, adjust, compromise, settle, determine, and allow the City's tort claim. If S.I.D. No. 225 fails to make final disposition of the City's tort claim within six months after it is filed, then the City will, via notice in writing, withdraw its tort claim from consideration of the governing body of S.I.D. No. 225 and begin suit in the District Court of Sarpy County.
