

**MEETING MINUTES OF
SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 235
OF SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA HELD ON NOVEMBER 16, 2016**

The meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 8:00 a.m. November 16, 2016 at 8901 South 154th Street, Omaha, Nebraska.

Present at the meeting were Trustees Mark Kinsey, Phyllis Peterson, Mary Nelson, Joseph Daffer and Karren McCall. Also present were Brian C. Doyle, attorney for the District, Lamp Rynearson & Associates, engineer for the District and Kuehl Capital Corporation, the financial advisor and fiscal agent for the District.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Bellevue Leader on October 26, 2016, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Trustees and a copy of their Acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice and in the notice to the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Clerk then certified that notice of this meeting had been given to the Sarpy County Clerk at least seven days prior to the time set by the Board of Trustees for this meeting and filed his Certificate to that effect, said Certificate being attached to these minutes and made a part hereof by this reference.

The Chairman publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The Clerk then stated that no petition opposing the Resolution of Necessity had been filed by any of the property owners within the District nor by any other person and no person appeared at the meeting or made any objections to the proposed Resolution of Necessity.

The Trustees Mark Kinsey, Phyllis Peterson, Mary Nelson, Joseph Daffer and Karren McCall then voted "aye" and passed and adopted the proposed Resolution of Advisability and Necessity, being the same Resolution adopted in form at the meeting of the Board of Trustees held

on October 13, 2016, which Resolution is set forth in full in the Proof of Publication attached hereto; the Trustees then passed the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the Resolution of Necessity for the Waste Collection be and hereby is approved as proposed at the meeting of the Board of Trustees held on November 16, 2016.

The Chairman then presented the Proof of Publication for the Notice to Contractors for the Waste Collection, to the effect that said Notice to Contractors had been published in the Bellevue Leader for three consecutive weeks on October 26, November 2, and November 9, 2016.

The Clerk then presented the list of bids and bidders for Waste Collection, said bids having been received on November 14, 2016, and presented together with a letter of recommendation of the engineers for the District, and the Clerk was directed to attach a copy of the letter of recommendation together with a copy of the bid tabulation to these minutes, After reviewing the letter of recommendation submitted by the engineers and determining that each of the bids was accompanied by the required bid bond and/or certified check, contract and maintenance bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price, it was determined that the recommendation of the engineers was that the bid of Abe's Trash Service, the low bidder in the amount of \$139,104.00 be accepted. After discussion, the following resolution was then duly made, seconded and upon a roll call vote of "aye" by the Trustees was duly adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the bid of Abe's Trash Service, for Waste Collection in the amount of \$139,104.00 be and hereby is accepted and that the Chairman and Clerk be there and hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract submitted in construction with said bid on behalf of the District.

The Chairman then presented plans and specifications prepared by Lamp Rynearson and Associates, Inc., engineers for the District, for Paving Maintenance 2017, together with an estimate of the total cost of said improvement prepared by said engineers, which cost estimate, including engineering fees, legal fees, fiscal fees, administration costs and other miscellaneous costs is in the sum of \$100,000.

After discussion the Resolution contained in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein was duly introduced, seconded and upon a roll call vote of "aye" by the Trustees, was unanimously adopted; the Trustees then passed the following resolutions:

RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the hearing on the proposed Resolution of Advisability and Necessity for Paving Maintenance 2017 shall be held at 8:30 a.m. on December 14, 2016 at 8901 South 154th Street, Omaha, Nebraska, at which time owners of property within the District who might become subject to assessment for the improvements contemplated by the proposed Resolution of Necessity may appear and make objections to the proposed improvements and if a petition opposing the proposed Resolution of Advisability and Necessity, signed by property owners representing a majority of the front footage which might become subject to assessments for the cost of said improvements, as set out in the Resolution, is filed with the Clerk of the District within three days before the date set for hearing on such Resolution, such Resolution shall not be passed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the notice of said hearing shall be given by publication in The Bellevue Leader, a legal newspaper of Sarpy County, Nebraska, for two consecutive weeks on November 30 and December 7, 2016, which publication shall contain the entire wording of the proposed Resolution and that notice shall be given by posting same in three conspicuous places within the boundaries of the District as required by §31-745 R.R.S.; and further, that the Clerk of the District shall give notice not less than seven days prior to said hearing to the City Clerk of Omaha, Nebraska as required by §31-727.02 R.R.S.

The Chairman then presented the following statements for payment from the General Fund Account of the District:

RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the Chairman and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver warrants of the District, dated the date of this meeting, to the following payees, for the following services and in the following amounts, said warrant to draw interest at the rate of 7% per annum, Warrant No. 1281 to be payable from the General Fund Account of the District and to be redeemed no later than three (3) years of the date hereof, being November 16, 2019.

- a) Warrant No. 1281 for \$5,999.21 payable to Lamp Rynearson & Associates for engineering services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska the District hereby authorizes and directs the Chairman or Clerk to file or cause to be filed, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149(e) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), pertaining to the General Fund Warrants.

No opinion of nationally recognized counsel in the area of municipal finance has been delivered with respect to the treatment of interest on the General Fund Warrants. Purchasers of the General Fund Warrants are advised to consult their tax advisors as to the tax consequences of purchasing or holding the General Fund Warrants.



BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska find and determine that it is advisable and necessary for the District to provide residential waste collection services within the boundaries of the District, said contract to be designated as Waste Collection and shall be performed as follows:

WASTE COLLECTION

The following is a general description of the work to be performed for the above-referenced project.

The services to be performed in this contract, located within easements too Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235, Sarpy County, shall consist of the removal and disposal of residential trash, yard waste and recyclables from all residences on a weekly basis within the boundary of the District, for a period of three years, from January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2019.

The outer boundaries of the area which may be subject to special assessments are the same as the outer boundaries of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska.

Plans and Specifications for said contract have been prepared by Lamp, Rymearson & Associates, Inc., engineers for the District and said engineers have filed with the Clerk of the District, prior to the first publication of this Resolution, an estimate of the total costs of said improvement, including engineering fees, legal fees, fiscal fees, interest and other miscellaneous costs, which estimate is in the sum of \$170,000.

To pay the cost of said contract the Board of Trustees shall have the power to issue negotiable bonds of the District after such improvements have been completed and accepted; said bonds to be called "Sanitary and Improvement District Bonds"

The Board of Trustees shall assess to the extent of special benefits, the cost of such services upon properties specially benefitted thereby. All special assessments which may be levied upon the properties specially benefitted by such improvements shall, when collected, be set aside and constitute a sinking fund for the payment of interest and principal of said bonds. The District shall also cause to be levied annually a tax upon the assessed value of all the taxable property in the District except intangible property, which to-

gether with said sinking fund derived from special assessments shall be sufficient to meet payment of the interest and principal of said bonds as the same become due; said tax shall be known as the Sanitary and Improvement District Tax and shall be payable annually in money.

If a petition opposing this Resolution, signed by property owners representing a majority of the front footage which may become subject to assessment for the cost of the improvements as set forth herein, is filed with the Clerk of the District within three (3) days before the date of the hearing on this Resolution, this Resolution shall not be passed.





NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska will be held at **8:30 A.M., on December 14, 2016, at 8901 S. 154th Street, Omaha, Nebraska**, which meeting will be open to the public. The agenda for such meeting, kept continuously current is available for public inspection at 11440 West Center Road, Omaha, Nebraska and includes the payment of bills of the District and the consideration and passing or amending and passing the following Resolution, to-wit:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska find and determine that it is advisable and necessary for the District to perform paving maintenance within the boundaries of the District, said improvement to be designated as Paving Maintenance 2017 and shall be constructed as follows:

PAVING MAINTENANCE 2017

The following is a general description of the work to be performed for the above-referenced project.

Repair paving in streets within the boundaries of the District, including saw-cutting, removal of existing paving, repair and preparation of subgrade, replacement of paving with Portal Cement Concrete, paving, sodding disturbed area and all work that may be considered incidental thereto in various locations in the streets.

The outer boundaries of the area which may be subject to special assessments are the same as the outer boundaries of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 235 of Sarpy County, Nebraska.

Plans and Specifications for said improvement have been prepared by Lamp, Rynearson & Associates, Inc., engineers for the District and said engineers have filed with the Clerk of the District, prior to the first publication of this Resolution, an estimate of the total costs of said improvement, including engineering fees, legal fees, fiscal fees, interest and other miscellaneous costs, which estimate is in the sum of \$100,000.

To pay the cost of said improvement the Board of Trustees shall have the power to issue negotiable bonds of the District after such improvements have been completed and accepted; said bonds to be called "Sanitary and Improvement District Bonds" and shall be payable and bear interest as provided by the Statutes of the State of Nebraska.

The Board of Trustees shall assess to the extent of special benefits, the cost of such improvements upon properties specially benefitted thereby. All special assessments which may

be levied upon the properties specially benefitted by such improvements shall, when collected, be set aside and constitute a sinking fund for the payment of interest and principal of said bonds. The District shall also cause to be levied annually a tax upon the assessed value of all of the taxable property in the District except intangible property, which together with said sinking fund derived from special assessments shall be sufficient to meet payment of the interest and principal of said bonds as the same become due; said tax shall be known as the Sanitary and Improvement District Tax and shall be payable annually in money.

If a petition opposing this Resolution, signed by property owners representing a majority of the front footage which may become subject to assessment for the cost of the improvements as set forth herein, is filed with the Clerk of the District within three (3) days before the date of the hearing on this Resolution, this Resolution shall not be passed.


