



MEETING MINUTES
SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 261
OF SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA

The meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 261 of Sarpy County, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 9 a.m. on October 21, 2014 at 11440 West Center Road, Omaha, Nebraska.

Present at the meeting were Trustees Barbara Udes Shaw, Chad LaMontagne, Jana M. Faller, Zachary Ziegenbein, Mandy Lortz and Chris Shannon. Also present was John H. Fullenkamp, attorney for the District.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Bellevue Leader on October 15, 2014, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Trustees and a copy of their Acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice and in the notice to the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Clerk then certified that notice of this meeting had been given to the Sarpy County Clerk at least seven days prior to the time set by the Board of Trustees for this meeting and filed her Certificate to that effect, said Certificate being attached to these minutes and made a part hereof by this reference.

The Clerk publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The attorney for the District then presented the Certification of Election Results reflecting that Jana M. Faller and Chad LaMontagne as designated representatives of Bellbrook Development LLC, Zachary J. Ziegenbein, Mandy Lortz and Chris Shannon had been elected as Trustees of the District to serve until the next election in accordance with the law. Discussion was then had concerning appointing a Chairman and Clerk of the District, whereupon, a motion was duly made, seconded and unanimously adopted appointing Chad LaMontagne as Chairman and Jana M. Faller as Clerk of the District. The Clerk was then directed to file bonds for the Chairman and Clerk in the respective amounts of \$5,000 and \$20,000 with the Sarpy County Clerk, and to attach a copy of the election results to these minutes.

The Clerk then presented the following statements for payment from the General Fund:

a) Omaha Public Power District for street lighting (Account No. 6160975096).	\$3,342.23
b) E & A Consulting Group for engineering services (#125961).	1,850.05
c) Montemarano Landscapes, Inc. for park maintenance (#23989, 24124).	10,203.00
d) Royal Lawns, Inc. for graffiti removal (#1856).	110.00
e) Stanek Construction Co. for installing radar system (#14-106).	250.00

The Chairman then advised that there is now due and owing Kuehl Capital Corporation the sum of \$393.89 in warrants at this time, payable from the General Fund Account of the District, which amount represents 2.5% of the principal amount of General Fund warrants issued at this meeting (\$15,755.28) in connection with advisory services relating to General Fund Warrants issued at this meeting.

The Chairman further advised that there is now due and owing RBC Capital Markets LLC the sum of \$322.99 in warrants at this time, payable from the General Fund Account of the District, which amount represents 2.0% of the principal amount of General Fund warrants issued at this meeting (\$16,149.17) for underwriting fee on General Fund warrants issued at this meeting.

Then, a motion was duly made, seconded and the following resolutions unanimously adopted:

RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 261 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the Chairman and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver Warrant Nos. 2707 through 2717, inclusive, of the District, to be dated the date of this meeting, to the following payees, for the following services and in the following amounts, said warrants to draw interest at the rate of 7% per annum, to be payable from the General Fund Account of the District and to be redeemed no later than three years from the date hereof, being October 21, 2017 ("the **General Fund Warrants**"), to-wit:

- a) Warrant No. 2707 for \$3,000.00 and Warrant No. 2708 for \$342.23 both payable to the Omaha Public Power District for street lighting.
- b) Warrant No. 2709 for \$1,850.05 payable to E & A Consulting Group for engineering services.
- c) Warrant Nos. 2710, 2711 and 2712 each for \$3,000.00 and Warrant No. 2713 for \$1,203.00 all payable to Montemarano Landscapes, Inc. for park maintenance.

d) Warrant No. 2714 for \$110.00 payable to Royal Lawns, Inc. for graffiti removal.

e) Warrant No. 2715 for \$250.00 payable to Stanek Construction Co. for installing rada system.


