Minutes of Meeting of Board of Trustees
August 11, 2015

A meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 282 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 11:00 a.m. on the 11th day of August, 2015 at the offices of Wick's Truck Trailer, 10580 South 147th Street, Omaha, Nebraska. Present were: Dawn M. Buck, Steve Wickersham, Corey Buck and Jamie Thompson.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Papillion Times on August 5, 2015, with a copy of the Affidavit of Publication being attached to these Minutes. Notice of the meeting was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Trustees, and their Acknowledgements of Receipt of Notice are attached to these Minutes. Notice has also been given to the County Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published Notice and in the Notice to the Trustees of the meeting; a copy of the meeting agenda is attached to these Minutes. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The following proceedings were had:

The meeting was called to order by Steve Wickersham, Chairman.

The Chairman publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The Chairman announced that the first matter for consideration was the approval of the Minutes of the meeting held on March 12, 2015. After a review and discussion of the Minutes, the Minutes were unanimously approved.

The Chairman announced that the next matter for consideration was the ratification of the engagement of Awerkamp Goodnight Schwaller & Nelson PC for accounting services to be provided to the District for the year ending June 30, 2015. The Chairman informed the Board that the District had received a letter outlining the accountants' duties and responsibilities in connection with the year-end and annual budget and he had executed the same in a timely manner. He announced that it would be appropriate to ratify and approve the execution of the engagement letter on behalf of the District. After thorough discussion and upon motion duly made, seconded and by roll call vote as follows:

The Board of Trustees authorized the employment of Awerkamp Goodnight Schwaller & Nelson PC as accountants for the District on the terms set forth in the accountants' proposal, and ordered and ratified the Chairman's execution of the proposal on behalf of the District.

The Chairman announced that the next matter for consideration was the ratification of warrants drawn on the General Fund Account of the District and payable to Omaha Public Power District. The Chairman announced that at a prior meeting the Chairman and Clerk were authorized to issue warrants payable to Omaha Public Power District for street and sign lights as they became due to avoid problems caused by payment delays occasioned by delays in meetings. Such warrants are to be ratified at the meeting following their issuance. As such, the Chairman

and Clerk issued the warrant in order to avoid further concerns with the past-due status of the invoice. The District ratifies the issuance as follows:

In addition, the Chairman announced that the next matter for discussion was the consideration of bills to be paid from the General Fund of the District. The Clerk presented statements from Lamp Rynearson & Associates, Inc. in the total sum of \$1,592.59 for engineering services; statement from World Herald Media Group in the total amount of \$10.25 for publication expense; a statement from Bankers Trust Company in the amount of \$750.00 for disclosure fee and annual administrative fees; a statement from Clean Sweep Commercial, Inc. in the amount of \$225.00 for street sweeping; a statement from Omaha Public Power District in the amount of \$673.39 for street and sign lighting; and a statement from Cornerstone Insurance Group in the amount of \$394.00 for liability insurance. Upon motion duly made, seconded and by roll call vote as follows:

the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 282 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the Chairman and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver Warrant Nos. 841 through 850 of the District, dated the date of this meeting, to the following payees and in the following amounts, said Warrants to be drawn on the General Fund of

the District and to draw interest at the rate of 7% per annum (interest to be payable at maturity) and to be redeemed no later than August 11, 2018, subject to extension of said maturity date by order of the District Court of Sarpy County, Nebraska, after notice is given as required by law, to wit:

- A. Warrant No. 841 in the amount of \$661.24, payable to Omaha Public Power District;
- B. Warrant No. 842 in the amount of \$667.15, payable to Omaha Public Power District;
- C. Warrant No. 843 in the amount of \$651.10, payable to Omaha Public Power District;
- D. Warrant No. 844 in the amount of \$659.82, payable to Omaha Public Power District;
- E. Warrant No. 845 in the amount of \$1,592.59, payable to Lamp Rynearson & Associates, Inc.;
- F. Warrant No. 846 in the amount of \$10.25, payable to World Herald Media Group;
- G. Warrant No. 847 in the amount of \$750.00, payable to Bankers Trust Company;
- H. Warrant No. 848 in the amount of \$225.00, payable to Clean Sweep Commercial, Inc.;
- I. Warrant No. 849 in the amount of \$673.39, payable to Omaha Public Power District; and
- J. Warrant No. 850 in the amount of \$394.00, payable to Cornerstone Insurance Group;

FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 282 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that both they and the district hereby find and determine and covenant, warrant and agree as follows: the improvements and/or facilities being financed or refinanced by the above Warrants are for essential governmental functions and are designed to serve members of the general public on an equal basis; all said improvements have from


the time of their first acquisition and construction being owned, are owned and are to be owned by the District or another political subdivision; to the extent special assessments have been or are to be levied for any of said improvements, such special assessments have been or are to be levied under Nebraska law as a matter of general application to all property specifically benefited by said improvements in the District; the development of the land in the District is for residential or commercial use and the development of the land in the District for sale and occupation by the general public has proceeded and is proceeding with reasonable speed; other than any incidental use of said improvements by a developer during the initial period of development of said improvements, there have been, are and will be no persons with rights to use such improvements other than as members of the general public; none of the proceeds of said Bonds or any refinanced indebtedness have been or will be loaned to any private person or entity; the District hereby authorizes and directs the Chairperson or Clerk to file or cause to be filed, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149(e) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, pertaining to the above Warrants; and the District does not reasonably expect to sell or otherwise dispose of said improvements and/or facilities, in whole or in part, prior to the last maturity of the above warrants.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 282 of Sarpy County, Nebraska that the District hereby covenants, warrants and agrees as follows: (a) to take all actions necessary under the current federal law to maintain the tax exempt status (as to taxpayers generally) of interest on the above Warrants; and (b) to the extent that it may lawfully do so, the District hereby designates the above Warrants as its "qualified tax exempt obligations" under Section 265(b)(3)(B)(i)(III) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended and covenants and warrants that the District does not reasonably expect to issue warrants or bonds or other obligations aggregating in the principal amount of more than \$10,000,000 during the calendar year in which the above Warrants are to be issued.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion duly made, seconded and by roll call vote as follows:

1. 
3. All of the subjects addressed at the Meeting were contained in the agenda for the Meeting, which agenda was kept continually current and readily available for public inspection at the address listed in the meeting notice for the Meeting and a copy of which is attached to this Certificate; such subjects were contained in said agenda for at least 24 hours prior to the Meeting and each agenda item was sufficiently descriptive to give the public reasonable notice of the matters to be considered at the Meeting.

A current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available and accessible to members of the public, posted during the Meeting in the room in which such Meeting was held and all in attendance at the Meeting were informed that such copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and were informed of the location of such copy in the room in which such Meeting was being held. All actions taken by the Board of Trustees referred to in said transcript were taken at a public meeting while open to the attendance of the public.
