


CERTIFICATE


The undersigned hereby certify that they are the Chairperson and Clerk of Sanitary and Improvement District Number 299 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, (the "District") and hereby further certify as follows:

1. Annexed to this certificate is a true and correct transcript of the proceedings of the Board of Trustees of the District relating to a meeting of said District held on the date and at the time reflected in the meeting minutes contained in said foregoing transcript (the "Meeting"). All of the proceedings of the District and of the Board of Trustees thereof which are set out in the annexed and foregoing transcript have been fully recorded in the journal of proceedings of the District and the undersigned District Clerk has carefully compared the annexed and foregoing transcript with said journal and with the records and files of the District which are in such Clerk's official custody and said transcript is a full, true and complete copy of said journal, records and files which are set out therein.
2. Advance notice for the Meeting was given by publication as set forth in the affidavit of publication contained in the foregoing transcript and was mailed to the Clerk of the municipality or county within whose zoning jurisdiction the District is located at least seven days prior to the date of the Meeting. Advance notice for the Meeting, including notice of agenda subjects, was given to all members of the Board of Trustees. All news media requesting notification of meetings of said body were provided with advance notice of the times and places of such meetings and the subjects to be discussed.
3. All of the subjects addressed at the Meeting were contained in the agenda for the Meeting, which agenda was kept continually current and readily available for public inspection at the address listed in the meeting notice for the Meeting and a copy of which is attached to this Certificate; such subjects were contained in said agenda for at least 24 hours prior to the Meeting and each agenda item was sufficiently descriptive to give the public reasonable notice of the matters to be considered at the Meeting.
4. A current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available and accessible to members of the public, posted during the Meeting in the room in which such Meeting was held and all in attendance at the Meeting were informed that such copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and were informed of the location of such copy in the room in which such Meeting was being held. At least one copy of all resolutions and other reproducible written materials, for which actions are shown in said proceedings, was made available for examination and copying by members of the public at the Meeting.
5. The minutes of the Meeting were in written form and available for public inspection within ten (10) working days after the Meeting or prior to the next convened meeting, whichever occurred earlier, at the office of the District; within thirty (30) days after the date of the Meeting, a copy of the minutes of the Meeting was sent to the Clerk of the municipality or county within whose zoning jurisdiction the District is located.
6. No litigation is now pending or threatened to restrain or enjoin the District from the issuance and delivery of any warrants or other obligations issued by the District or the levy and collection of tax or other revenues or relating to any of the improvements for which any such warrants or other obligations were or are issued nor in any manner questioning the proceedings and authority under which any such warrants or other obligations were or are issued or affecting the validity thereof; neither the corporate existence or boundaries of the District nor the title of its present officers to their respective offices is being contested; no authority or proceedings for the issuance of any warrants or other obligations by the District have been repealed, revoked or rescinded as of the date hereof. All actions taken by the Board of Trustees referred to in said transcript were taken at a public meeting while open to the attendance of the public.

Notice was given in advance thereof by publication in the Papillion Times, the designated method for giving notice on January 29, 2014 and February 5, 2014, a copy of the proof of publication being attached to these minutes, as well as by posting in three conspicuous places within the District, a copy of the certificate of posting being attached to these minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board of Trustees, and a copy of their acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice and in the notice of the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Clerk publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

The Chairperson advised that the first order of business was to move for the adoption of the Resolution of Necessity for Sanitary Sewer – Section I within the District, which was proposed at the meeting of the Board of Trustees held on January 15, 2014.

The Clerk advised that the following written objections were received from the following persons appearing in person or by their attorney to object to the adoption of the Resolution of Necessity: None.

Trustee Gerald L. Torczon introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Chairperson and the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 299 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the Resolution of Necessity for Sanitary Sewer – Section I proposed for adoption at the meeting of the Board of Trustees held on January 15, 2014 be adopted.

Trustee Doris Nicholson seconded the motion and on roll call the following voted in favor of the same: Gerald L. Torczon, Doris Nicholson, John Torczon, Jeff Torczon and Neil Smith.

The following vote nay: None.

Thereupon, the Chairperson declared the motion carried and said resolution was passed and adopted.

The Chairperson then presented to the Board the Engineers tabulation of bids received February 12, 2014 for Sanitary Sewer – Section I with the recommendation to award the contract to the lowest and best bidder.

It is hereby determined that the following is the lowest and best bid received on the above-mentioned project:


Tab Construction Company	\$555,342.65

Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the Chairperson and Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 299 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, held at 2:00 p.m. on January 15, 2014...
THEREAFTER, the Resolution may be amended or passed as proposed. Any petition opposing the Resolution of Necessity shall be filed with the Clerk of the District at 1246 Golden Gate Drive, Suite 1, Papillion, Nebraska, within three days before the date of the meeting for the hearing on the proposed Resolution of Necessity. Said Resolution is as follows:

RESOLUTION FOR NECESSITY

BE IT RESOLVED BY the Chairperson and Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 299 of Sarpy County, Nebraska:
Section 1. The Chairperson and Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 299 of Sarpy County, find and determine that it is desirable to propose a Resolution of Necessity for the purpose of constructing a Sanitary Sewer in the District.
Section 2. It is hereby declared to be necessary and advisable for the District to construct a Sanitary Sewer for the District as well as all necessary appurtenances thereto and in connection therewith the description of the work to be performed is as follows:

SANITARY SEWER - SECTION 1

- Construct PVC sanitary sewer pipes, or other approved materials together with manholes and service laterals, and perform all work necessary or incidental thereto in the following locations:
131st Street/131st Street Drive/Overline Drive
Commencing at a point 1 foot North and 25 feet East of the Northeast corner of Lot 11; thence Southwesterly an 8" pipe 575 feet to a point 11 feet North and 18 feet East of the Northwest corner of Lot 4; thence Easterly an 8" pipe 827 feet to a point 29 feet South and 15 feet West of the Southwest corner of Lot 83; thence Southwesterly an 8" pipe 1,348 feet to a point 84 feet South and 337 feet East of the South corner of Lot 160; thence Southwesterly an 8" pipe 480 feet to a point 1,108 feet South and 452 feet East of the South corner of Lot 160.
141st Street
Commencing at a point 1 foot North and 25 feet East of the Northeast corner of Lot 33; thence Southwesterly an 8" pipe 518 feet to a point 27 feet South and 32 feet West of the Southwest corner of Lot 160.
Access Drive
Commencing at a point 1 foot North and 32 feet West of the Northwest corner of Lot 141; thence Southwesterly an 8" pipe 1,378 feet to a point 81 feet South and 12 feet East of the corner of Lot 81.
Recreation Street/136th Street
Commencing at a point 10 feet South and 19 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 14; thence Easterly an 8" pipe 930 feet to a point 23 feet South and 45 feet East of the Southeast corner of Lot 4; thence Southwesterly an 8" pipe 1,062 feet to a point 68 feet South and 14 feet East of the Southeast corner of Lot 87.
Schofield Drive
Commencing at a point 12 feet North and 25 feet East of the East corner of Lot 158; thence Northerly an 8" pipe 190 feet to a point 58 feet South and 14 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 87.
188th Street
Commencing at a point 25 feet South of the Southwest corner of Lot 107; thence Southwesterly an 8" pipe 922 feet to a point 58 feet South and 14 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 116.
Schofield Drive
Commencing at a point 12 feet North and 25 feet East of the East corner of Lot 155; thence Northerly an 8" pipe 190 feet to a point 58 feet South and 14 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 116.
188th Street
Commencing at a point 1 foot North and 25 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 125; thence Southwesterly an 8" pipe 613 feet to a point 58 feet South and 14 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 131.
Hancock Street
Commencing at a point 15 feet North and 27 feet East of the East corner of Lot 152; thence Northerly an 8" pipe 190 feet to a point 58 feet South and 14 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 131.
187th Avenue/Circle
Commencing at a point 50 feet West of the Northwest corner of Lot 136; thence Southwesterly an 8" pipe 259 feet to a point 62 feet South and 11 feet East of the Southeast corner of Lot 136.
Shoeb Circle
Commencing at a point 38 feet North and 32 feet East of the Northwest corner of Lot 147; thence Northerly an 8" pipe 274 feet to a point 62 feet South and 11 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 158.

The outer boundaries of the areas which may become subject to special assessment for said improvement are proposed to be the same as the outer boundaries of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 299 of Sarpy County, Nebraska.
Section 3: That the plans and specifications for the Sanitary Sewer system have been prepared by Larry Rymerson & Associates, consulting engineers employed by the District for such purpose, and on January 14, 2014, were filed with the Clerk of the District prior to the first publication of this Resolution. Said engineers have also made and on January 14, 2014, did file in estimate of the total costs of the proposed improvements, which costs as estimated by said engineers are as follows:
Estimated total project cost \$448,600.00

Section 4: To pay the cost of said improvement the Board of Trustees shall have the power to issue negotiable bonds of the District after such improvements have been completed and accepted; said bonds to be called "Sanitary and Improvement District Bonds" and shall be payable and bear interest as provided by the Statutes of the State of Nebraska.
The Board of Trustees shall assess to the extent of special benefits, the cost of such improvements upon properties specially benefited thereby; such special assessments which may be levied upon the properties specially benefited by such improvements shall, when collected, be set aside and constitute a sinking fund for the payment of interest and principal of said bonds. The District shall also cause to be levied annually a tax upon the assessed value of all of the taxable property in the District except blighted property, which together with said sinking fund derived from special assessments shall be sufficient to meet payment of the interest and principal of said bonds as the same become due; said tax shall be known as the Sanitary and Improvement District Tax and shall be payable annually in money.

Said resolution contingent upon the plans and specifications for said Sanitary Sewer being approved by the City of Gretna.
If a petition opposing the Resolution, signed by property owners representing a majority of the front footage which may become subject to assessment for the cost of the improvements as set forth herein, is filed with the Clerk of the District within three (3) days before the date of the hearing on this Resolution, this Resolution shall not be passed.




