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



The undersigned hereby certify that they are they Chairman and the Clerk of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 306 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, (the "District") and hereby further certify as follows:


1. Annexed to this Certificate is a true and correct transcript of the proceedings of the Board of Trustees of the District relating to a meeting of said District held on the date and at the time reflected in the meeting minutes contained in said foregoing transcript (the "Meeting"). All of the proceedings of the District and of the Board of Trustees thereof which are set out in the annexed and foregoing transcript have been fully recorded in the journal of proceedings of the District and the undersigned District Clerk has carefully compared the annexed and foregoing transcript with said journal and with the records and files of the District which are in such Clerk's official capacity and said transcript is a full and complete copy of said journal, records and files which are set out therein.
2. Advance notice for the Meeting was given by publication as set forth in the affidavit of publication contained in the foregoing transcript and was mailed to the Clerk of the municipality or county within whose zoning jurisdiction the District is located at least seven days prior to the date of the Meeting. Advance notice for the Meeting, including notice of agenda subjects, was given to all members of the Board of Trustees. All news media requesting notification of meetings of said body were provided with advance notice of the times and places of such meetings and subjects to be discussed.

All of the subjects addressed at the Meeting were contained in the agenda for the Meeting, which agenda was kept continuously current and readily available for public inspection at the address listed in the meeting notice for the Meeting and a copy of which is attached to this Certificate; such subjects were contained in said agenda for at least 24 hours prior to the Meeting and each agenda item was sufficiently descriptive to give the public reasonable notice of the matters to be considered at the Meeting.

A current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available and accessible to members of the public, posted during the Meeting in the room in which such Meeting was held and all in attendance at the Meeting were informed that such copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and were informed of the location of such copy in the room in which such Meeting was being held. **MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
SANITARY AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 306 OF
SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA HELD AT 11:00 A.M. ON FEBRUARY 3, 2016 AT
10064 SOUTH 134th STREET, OMAHA, NEBRASKA**

The meeting of the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 306 of Sarpy County, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 11:00 a.m. on February 3, 2016 at 10064 South 134th Street, Omaha, Nebraska.

Present at the meeting were Trustees Jonathan M. Meyers, James Meyers, Tamara Meyers-Draeger, Bruce Meyers and Joseph Meyers. Also present were Jeff Farnham and Andrea Griffin, Attorneys for the District.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in *The Papillion Times* on January 27, 2016, a copy of the Proof of Publication being attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was simultaneously given to all members of the Board of Trustees and a copy of their Acknowledgement of Receipt of Notice is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the published notice and in the notice to the Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings of the Board were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Clerk then certified that notice of this meeting had been given to the Sarpy County Clerk at least seven days prior to the time set by the Board of Trustees for this meeting and filed his Certificate to that effect, said Certificate being attached to these minutes.

The Chairman then stated that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and inspection and stated the location of said copy in the room in which such meeting was held.

There was next presented Invoice No. 113477 from Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc. for engineering services in connection with Paving and Storm Sewer – Section 1 in the amount of Eighteen Thousand Eight Hundred Thirteen and 05/100 Dollars (\$18,813.05). The Clerk was directed to attach a copy of such Invoice to these minutes. The Chairman recommended the issuance of a warrant for such amount to Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc. The Chairman noted that the Resolution of

Advisability and Necessity for Paving and Storm Sewer – Section 1 was passed and approved by the Board on June 10, 2015.

The Chairman then presented a copy of a Certificate of Completion wherein Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc., the District's engineer, certifies that MFT Construction, Inc. has completed the construction of the project known as Paving and Storm Sewer – Section 1 in substantial compliance with the plans and specifications. The Clerk was directed to attach a copy of such Certificate of Completion to these minutes.

There was next presented Payment Recommendation No. 3 from Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc. recommending payment to MFT Construction, Inc. in connection with the project known as Paving and Storm Sewer – Section 1, in the amount of One Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy Seven and 35/100 Dollars (\$199,977.35). The Clerk was directed to attach a copy of such Payment Recommendation No. 3 to these minutes. The Chairman recommended the issuance of a warrant for such amount to MFT Construction, Inc. The Chairman noted that the Resolution of Advisability and Necessity for Paving and Storm Sewer – Section 1 was passed and approved by the Board on June 10, 2015.

There was next presented Invoice No. 306-05 from Farnham & Simpson, PC, LLO for legal services in connection with the payment of Paving and Storm Sewer – Section 1 Payment Recommendation No. 3 in the total amount of Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Eight and 87/100 Dollars (\$9,998.87). The Clerk was directed to attach a copy of such Invoice to these minutes. The Chairman recommended the issuance of a warrant for such amount to Farnham & Simpson, PC, LLO. The Chairman noted that the Resolution of Advisability and Necessity for Paving and Storm Sewer – Section 1 was passed and approved by the Board on June 10, 2015.

There was next presented Invoice No. 113710 from Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc. for miscellaneous engineering services in the amount of Five Hundred Nineteen and 70/100 Dollars (\$519.70). The Clerk was directed to attach a copy of such Invoice to these minutes. The Chairman recommended the issuance of a warrant for such amount to Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc.

The Clerk next directed the attention of the Board of Trustees to the fact that D.A. Davidson & Co. will place Two Hundred Twenty Nine Thousand Three Hundred Eight and 97/100 Dollars (\$229,308.97) in warrants at this time and that the contracted charge for such placement of warrants is five percent (5%) or Eleven Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Five and 45/100 Dollars (\$11,465.45) in accordance with the financing agreement previously adopted by the Board. The Chairman recommended the issuance of a warrant for such amount to D.A. Davidson & Co.

The previously described bills, invoices, recommendations and statements having been presented for the Board's consideration and after review and discussion of such items, the following Resolution was duly moved and passed:

RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 306 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the Chairman and Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute and deliver Warrant Nos. 219-244 of the District, dated the date of this meeting, to the following payees and in the following amounts, said Warrants to be drawn on the Construction Fund of the District and to draw interest at the date of seven percent (7%) per annum (interest to be payable on February 10 of each year) and to be redeemed no later than February 3, 2021, subject to extension of said maturity date by order of the District Court of Sarpy County, Nebraska, after notice is given as required by law, to wit:

Warrant No. 212 for the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) and Warrant No. 213 for the amount of Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Thirteen and 05/100 Dollars (\$8,813.05) payable to Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc. in payment of Invoice No. 113477 in connection with Paving and Storm Sewer – Section 1.

Warrants Nos. 221-239 for the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) each and Warrant No. 240 for the amount of Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy Seven and 35/100 Dollars (\$9,977.35), payable to MFT Construction, Inc. pursuant to Payment Recommendation No. 3 in connection with the project known as Sanitary Sewer – Section 1.

Warrant No. 241 for the amount of Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Eight and 35/100 Dollars (\$9,998.87) payable to Farnham & Simpson, PC, LLO in payment of

Invoice No. 306-05 for legal services in connection with Sanitary Sewer – Section 1.

Warrant No. 242 for the amount of Five Hundred Nineteen and 70/100 Dollars (\$519.70) payable to Thompson, Dreessen & Dorner, Inc. in payment of Invoice No. 113477 in connection with Paving and Storm Sewer – Section 1.

Warrant No. 243 for the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) and Warrant No. 244 for the amount of One Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Five and 45/100 Dollars (\$1,465.45) payable to D.A. Davidson & Co. for the placement and/or sale of Construction Fund warrants issued at this meeting.

FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 306 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that both they and the District hereby find and determine and covenant, and warrant and agree that (a) the facilities for which the above Warrants are issued are for essential government functions and are designed to serve members of the general public on an equal basis; (b) there are no persons with rights to use said facilities other than as members of the general public; (c) ownership and operation of said facilities is within the District or another political subdivision; (d) none of the proceeds of the Warrants will be loaned to any person and to the extent that special assessments have been or are to be levied under Nebraska law as a matter of general application to all property specifically benefited by such facilities in the District; (e) the development of the land in the District is for residential or commercial use; (f) the development of the land in the District for sale and occupation by the general public is proceeding with reasonable speed; and (g) the District hereby authorized and directs the Chairman or Clerk to file, when due, an information reporting form pursuant to Section 149(e) of the Internal Revenue Code pertaining to the above Warrants.


FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 306 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that the District hereby covenants, warrants and agrees as follows: (a) to take all actions necessary under current federal law to maintain the tax exempt status (as to taxpayers generally) of interest on the above Warrants; and (b) to the extent that it may lawfully do so, the District hereby designates the above Warrants as its "qualified tax exempt obligations" under Section 265(b)(3)(B)(i)(III) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and covenants and warrants that the District does not reasonably expect to issue warrants or

bonds or other obligations aggregating in the principal amount of \$5,000,000.00 during the calendar year in which the above Warrants are to be issued.

FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 306 of Sarpy County, Nebraska, that this and the preceding Resolutions are hereby adopted as the Certificate With Respect to Arbitrage of the District pertaining to the above Warrants and the District and the Chairman and Clerk of the District hereby further certify, as of the date of the registration of the above Warrants with the County Treasurer of Sarpy County, Nebraska, as follows:

1. No separate reserve or replacement fund has been or will be established with respect to the above Warrants. The District reasonably anticipates that monies in its Bond Fund reasonably attributable to the above Warrants in excess of the lesser of: (a) ten percent (10%) of the net principal proceeds of the above Warrants, (b) the maximum annual debt service due on the above Warrants, or (c) one hundred twenty-five percent (125%) of average annual debt service due on the above Warrants will be expended for payment of principal and interest on the above Warrants within thirteen (13) months after receipt of such monies. That amount which is currently held in the District's Bond Fund which exceeds the amount which is to be expended on payment of principal and interest on the above Warrants within thirteen (13) months after receipt of such monies, plus that amount arrived at pursuant to the immediately preceding sentence, will not be invested in any securities or any other investment obligations which bear a yield, as computed in accordance with the actuarial method, in excess of the yield on the above Warrants.
2. To the best of their knowledge, information and belief, the above expectations are reasonable.
3. The District has not been notified of any listing of it by the Internal Revenue Service as an issuer that may not certify its bonds.
4. This Certificate is being passed, executed and delivered pursuant to Section 1.148-2(b)(2) of the Income Tax Regulations under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting was adjourned.
