WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 1997), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Board approved a Vehicle Acquisition and Disbursement Policy on January 13, 1998 governing in part the disposal of surplus vehicles: and,

WHEREAS, the following vehicles have been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County:

1. 1996 Ford Crown Vic - VIN 2FALP71W2TX141393
2. 1998 Ford Crown Vic - VIN 2FAFP71W0WX152121

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that aforementioned vehicles are hereby declared to be surplus property and authorizes the Purchasing Department to dispose of the vehicles in the best interest of Sarpy County.


