WHEREAS,

- A) An engineering study has been conducted on Capehart Road from 84<sup>th</sup> Street to 48<sup>th</sup> Street by the County's Surveyor / Engineer to reduce the speed from 50 mph to 40 mph and,
- B) The Surveyor/Engineer recommends speed reduction to 40 mph from 84<sup>th</sup> Street to 48<sup>th</sup> Street on Capehart Road

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS BOARD THAT:

- 1) The recommendation of the County Surveyor/Engineer for a speed reduction on Capehart Road is hereby accepted, adopted, approved, ratified and confirmed.
- 2) On Capehart Road, the speed limit shall be 40miles per hour from 84<sup>th</sup> Street to 48<sup>th</sup> Street.
- 3) This County's Surveyor/Engineer shall take such steps to post appropriate uniform traffic control devices at each location to notify the traveling public of the speed limit now established.
- 4) This resolution is authorized by Neb. Rev. Stat. 60-680, Reissue 2004.

SUBJECT: Resolution to reduce the Speed Limit on Capehart Road



- a) Sarpy County Highway Department will be placing signs to make the public aware of the Speed Reduction as per the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
- b) Sarpy County Highway Department will be notifying the Sarpy County Sheriffs Department of the change that will take place at the intersection.

The Sarpy County Surveyors/Engineers office has reviewed the proposed Speed Reduction location in question. It is our recommendation that the signs are to be placed at the location shown on the plan that was submitted.
