WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 1997), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the 16 KVA Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) Unit has been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that the 16 KVA Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) Unit is hereby declared to be surplus property and the Purchasing Department is hereby authorized to dispose of the UPS Unit in the best interest of Sarpy County.


TO: Sarpy County Board of Commissioners
