RESOLUTION DECLARING VEHICLES SURPLUS PROPERTY
AND TRANSFERRING VEHICLE TO JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTER

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 1997), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 1997), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Board approved a Vehicle Acquisition and Disbursement Policy on January 13, 1998 governing in part the disposal and transfer of surplus vehicle: and,

WHEREAS, the following vehicles as described on attached Exhibit A, have been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County:


- Unit B5 - 2001 Ford Crown Vic - Building Permits & Inspection
