**RESOLUTION INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE 2009 FY NOXIOUS WEED BUDGET**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 2007), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, additional appropriations are needed for the continued operation of the various funds listed below after the adoption of the 2009 fiscal year budget; and,

WHEREAS, Section 13-511 provides that the previously adopted budget may be supplemented after conducting a public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners, that the following funds are hereby increased:

Noxious Weed fund budget is hereby increased by \$2,000 from \$81,517 to \$83,517. The source of revenue to cover the increase in budgeted expenditures will be a permanent transfer from the Inheritance Tax fund.



Subject: Overdrawn Budget

Brian, In October of 2008 the Noxious Weed Department purchased a Yamaha Grizzly ATV from Hats off Motorsports in Bellevue. The total purchase price was \$8,148. The Papio NRD paid \$5,000 towards the purchase of the ATV. The remainder \$3,148 was paid by the noxious weed department. This purchase was approved by the previous County Board.

The ATV was not a budget item for fiscal year 2008-2009. For the remainder of the year, noxious weed has made sincere efforts to stay as close to budget as possible. The noxious weed budget overage will exceed \$2,000.
