WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 1997), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 1997), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the two (2) L-3 SYS210 x-ray machines, Serial Numbers 55571 & 55540 and one (1) Heimann Hi-Scan 2416 System, S/N # 11123 has been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that the three (3) x-ray machines described above be hereby declared surplus property and the Purchasing Department is hereby authorized to dispose of the x-ray machines in the best interest of Sarpy County.

## MEMO

TO: Sarpy County Board of Commissioners

RE: Resolution of Surplus X-Ray Machines

Please find below the description of three (3) old x-ray machines that Sarpy County Sheriff's Court Services is requesting permission to surplus.

Two (2) x-ray machines are L-3 SYS210 models and one (1) is a Heimann Hi-Scan 2416 system. These machines were not cost effective to repair and have been replaced by newer models. One of the bidders for new x-ray machines, quoted \$1,000.00 per machine to dispose of the equipment. The County has five (5) pieces of equipment for recycle, three (3) x-ray machines and two (2) microfiche/printers.

Gary Mackeprang, Court Services, researched other companies that handle the disposal of these types of equipment. Electronics Disposal Technologies, Inc. has a contract with the State of Nebraska for disposal of these various types of equipment. EDT can accept the machines for a salvage fee of \$0.20 per pound. The three x-ray machines weigh 1,300 lbs each. The disposal fee would be approximately \$260.00 each x-ray machine and the two microfiche machines would be only a fraction of that cost with addition of any trucking fee. EDT would pick up the equipment and deliver them to their facility to be weighed. They will send the County an invoice, which will state the weight, transfer of possession for disposal, and release of liability.

It is recommended that the attached Resolution, declaring three (3) x-ray machines surplus property, be signed.
