Within sixty (60) days from the date of this award the reimbursement request must be submitted to NOHS. After sixty (60) days, reimbursements will not be honored. Re: Nebraska Office of Highway Safety Mini-Grant Application and Award for in-car cameras for the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office

On October 20, 2009, the County Board will be asked to approve the submission of the attached mini-grant application and award for radars for the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office.

The grant will provide funding for the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) to purchase 6 in-car cameras for use in SCSO cruisers. The grant application requests \$21,000. The Nebraska Office of Highway Safety will reimburse Sarpy County up to \$3,500 per camera through this mini-grant. The total cost of each camera is \$5,615; therefore Sarpy County will be responsible for \$2,122 for each camera for a total cost of \$12,735.
