

I have numerous grants scheduled for your consideration and approval on October 27, 2009. I will outline the specifics in this letter and will be present at the meeting if any questions. Please also feel free to call me at anytime with questions or concerns at 681-0929

**"You Drink & Drive, you lose"** This campaign is an annual event 100% funded by the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety. Our grant request this year is for \$28,411.34. This will provide for extra deputies to patrol during the holiday season including New Years Eve and New Years Day.

**"PRIDE Omaha, Tobacco Compliance Checks"** PRIDE Omaha every year relies on the Sarpy County Sheriff to complete Tobacco Compliance checks. This year they have authorized \$3,350 for the checks to be completed quarterly thru June 30, 2010. This also is a 100% funding, no local funding. This contract is also renewal every year. We have participated in this grant for several years.

**"PRIDE Omaha/Live Wise Coalition, MIP Underage party patrols"** Every year PRIDE Omaha and the Live Wise Coalition provide 100% funding to provide MIP(Minor in possession of Alcohol) party patrols. These funds are at our discretion and scheduling for needed activities such as High School Graduation, Proms, and Homecomings etc. This year we are authorized \$2500 for 6 MIP patrols. This grant also allows us to be eligible at the ending of the fiscal year for additional funds if available.

**"UASI, Homeland Security Grant"**. We have the opportunity to purchase CBRNE (Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, and Explosive) equipment under the grant with 2006 remaining funds. This equipment, 10 CBRNE Masks, and 63 replacement breathing filters is 100% funded thru UASI (Urban Area Security Initiative ) and purchased and billed thru the City Of Omaha, who is the fiscal agent. We simply apply and receive the equipment with all funding thru the city of Omaha. All of this equipment will be inventoried and become property of Sarpy County. Total cost of this equipment is \$6977.72

**"Preliminary Alcohol Breath testing equipment"** Each year the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety provides participating agencies in DWI enforcement 6 Preliminary Breath Testers, or Alco Sensors as they are commonly referred to. This year I did request 7 units at state bid of \$350 each or a total of \$2450. This grant if approved allows NOHS to purchase and ship the units to us. There will not be any billing or exchange thru Sarpy County.

**"Click it or Ticket"**. This is another annual event thru the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety. The campaign runs November 23-29, 2009 and will provide 4 extra deputies each day (7 days) for 4 hours each day. The grant request is for \$5477.29 with no matching funds.

All of these grants are 100% funded; no matching funds will be used. These grants total \$49,166.35. Once again, thanks for your consideration of these items and please call if any questions,.
