The main responsibilities and powers of the Board members include; reviewing grievances or cases of disciplinary action of the bargaining unit employee and issue a determination that is binding on all parties concerned. Other duties include issuing subpoenas to compel the attendance of county employees as witnesses and the production of documents and to administer oaths, take testimony, hear proof and receive exhibits in evidence.
