BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, By the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that the Board Chairman is hereby authorized to sign the Application, Certifications and Assurances, and all other related documents for the Sarpy County Juvenile Reporting Center grant upon completion of the grant application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, By the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners, that the Chairman of such Board is hereby authorized to sign a letter of support encouraging the award of the grant.



Re: Sarpy County Juvenile Reporting Center grant

On December 15, the County Board will be asked to give Carrie Davis-Sedlacek permission to write the 2010-2011 Juvenile Reporting Center grant proposal and authorize the Chairperson to sign the application and related documents upon completion of the grant proposal.

The grant is due on January 8, 2010; due to the timeframe of the grant announcement and due date and the Board meeting schedule I will not have an opportunity to present the completed application to the Board before it must be submitted. Therefore I am requesting the Board authorize the Chairperson to sign the application and related documents (i.e.: Certifications, Assurance, and Letter of Support) prior to the next Board meeting on January 12, 2010.


This is a continuation grant that will fund the Center at 25% of the initial grant award which was \$75,000. Last year's funding was \$37,491. Due to the "step-down" funding formula, the Center is eligible for and will be requesting \$18,750 for the 2010-2011 fiscal year which will cover a portion of the salary and benefits of one Youth Attendant to provide programming and supervision to youth at the Center. Current personnel costs for this position are approximately \$39,636. The County match has been increased due to comments received from the reviewers on the 2009-2010 grant application. The review committee strongly suggested the County show a higher match amount. The County will match with \$18,750 which is a portion of the salary and benefits for the Reporting Center Coordinator; however, **the County will still be responsible for about \$20,886 in personnel costs for this position due to the decrease in grant funding. Furthermore, this is the last year of funding from this particular grant.** The Program will be eligible to apply for a new grant in fiscal year 2011-2012 if it can prove an increased need and show good reason to receive new funding.

The Center provides programming and supervision for youth who have been referred by Probation, Diversion, or the CARE program or have been ordered by the Court to attend services.

I will be present to answer questions related to the grant application and the application process. A representative from the Juvenile Reporting Center will be in attendance to answer any programmatic questions and present additional information.


