Re: Sarpy County Pretrial Juvenile Assessment Center grant

On December 15, the County Board will be asked to give Carrie Davis-Sedlacek permission to write the 2010-2011 Pretrial Juvenile Assessment Center grant proposal and authorize the Chairperson to sign the application and related documents upon completion of the grant proposal.

The grant is due on January 8, 2010; due to the timeframe of the grant announcement and due date and the Board meeting schedule I will not have an opportunity to present the completed application to the Board before it must be submitted. Therefore I am requesting the Board authorize the Chairperson to sign the application and related documents (i.e.: Certifications, Assurance, and Letter of Support) prior to the next Board meeting on January 12, 2010.

This is a continuation grant that will fund the Center at 25% of the initial grant award which was \$43,444. Last year's funding was \$32,583. Due to the "step-down" funding formula, the Center is eligible for and will be requesting \$10,871 for the 2010-2011 fiscal year which will cover a portion of the salary and benefits of the Juvenile Assessment Officer. Current personnel costs for this position are approximately \$49,845. The County match has been increased due to comments received from the reviewers on the 2009-2010 grant application. The review committee strongly suggested the County show a higher match amount. The County will match with \$10,871 which is a portion of the remaining salary and benefits for the Juvenile Assessment Officer; however, **the County will still be responsible for about \$38,974 in personnel costs for this position due to the decrease in grant funding. Furthermore, this is the last year of funding from this particular grant.** The Program will be eligible to apply for a new grant in fiscal year 2011-2012 if it can prove an increased need and show good reason to receive new funding.

Youth and their families are assessed at the PJAC to identify both individual and family issues that contributed to the youth entering the juvenile justice system. Each assessment includes the Simple Screening Inventory (SSI), the Youth Level of Services/Case Management Inventory (YLS/CMI), the Maysi-2, the Suicide Risk Inventory, the Strength Based Questionnaire, and a parent interview. Based on the personal, family, social, educational, and legal circumstances each youth presents, recommendations are shared with the assigned Juvenile Diversion Officer. The Diversion Officer and Juvenile Assessment Officer utilize the assessment recommendations and scores to design individualized case management programs to assist the youth in developing the skills necessary to decrease the likelihood of becoming further involved in the juvenile justice system.

I will be present to answer questions related to the grant application and the application process. A representative from the Pretrial Juvenile Assessment Center will be in attendance to answer any programmatic questions and present additional information.


