RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PERMANENT TRANSFER
FOR THE 2010 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6)(Reissue 2007), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103(Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of Sarpy County to transfer available cash funds from the Landfill Bond Surplus fund to the County General fund to cover lower than anticipated General fund revenues for the 2010 fiscal year.



Landfill Bond Surplus (3401357 570200) to General (037059 459002) \$1,250,000.00



Re: Transfer to County General Fund

As was discussed at the County Board Budget Retreat in January, a number of General Fund revenues are coming in at rates quite a bit below the 2009 FY level, e.g. investment interest and juvenile detention revenues. This will in turn cause the cash fund balance to be lower. There are funds available in the Landfill Bond Surplus Fund (current balance is \$3.5MM) that can be transferred to the General Fund to help bolster the cash balance. The monies in the Landfill Bond Surplus Fund were built up over time for the possible purchase of a future landfill site. After several studies, it appears very unlikely that Sarpy County will purchase another landfill site.

I recommend approval of the attached Resolution that will transfer \$1,250,000 from the Landfill Bond Surplus Fund to the County General Fund.
