PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this Mini-Grant Contract is to provide funding assistance to law enforcement agencies for selective overtime enforcement in the emphasis area of: (Check One) Alcohol [X], Speed [], or General Traffic [].

Please complete items 1 - 5 below using the definitions on the reverse side, and submit a copy of your department's current seat belt policy and drug-free workplace policy.

- 1. Baseline Information: Project X Mile enforcement effort to conduct compliance checks for establishments selling alcohol to minors, also selective MIP enforcement.
2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective: To reduce sales of alcohol to minors and to reduce alcohol consumption by minors.
3. Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity: Officers will send an informant to an establishment and attempt to purchase alcohol.
4. Selective Overtime Enforcement Budget: 12 deputies @ \$63.34 x 80 hours = \$5,067.26. Social Security tax = \$387.65. Retirement = \$443.39. Total budget = \$5,898.30.
5. Impact Evaluation: The compliance rate this enforcement will be compared to previous compliance rates for the same type of efforts.

This Mini-Grant Contract is financed on a reimbursement basis. The applicant must first be approved for the activity by the NOHS, then incur the expenses (pay the bills) in order to be reimbursed for the federal share of the Mini-Grant Contract.

- 1) Invoice - from the applicant to the NOHS.
2) Copies of the pre- and post publicity announcing the overtime enforcement activity.
3) Activity Report and Project Summary.
4) Total miles driven (if mileage reimbursement is requested).
5) Provide the name, number of hours worked, regular and overtime hourly rates for each officer.
6) Provide the amount paid to each officer and payroll documents to substantiate each expenditure.

Within sixty (60) days from the conclusion of the activity the reimbursement request must be submitted. After sixty (60) days, reimbursements will not be honored. Acceptance of Conditions: The Mini-Grant Contract Award recipient agrees to all applicable federal and state laws, rules and regulations.

Re: The Selective Alcohol Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant Award between the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety and the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office

On May 4, 2010, the County Board will be asked to ratify The Selective Alcohol Overtime Enforcement Award for the attached mini-grant with the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety (NOHS) and the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office (SCSO). The grant was applied for and submitted by the SCSO. Sheriff Davis signed the award on March 25, 2010.
