Within sixty (60) days from the conclusion of the activity the reimbursement request must be submitted. After sixty (60) days, reimbursements will not be honored. Acceptance of Conditions: The Mini-Grant Contract Award recipient agrees to all applicable federal and state laws, rules and regulations. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in termination of this Grant Contract Award. All Awards are subject to availability of Federal Funding.

Re: Safety Saturday enforcement

1. Baseline Information

The Sarpy County Sheriff Department is applying for the "Safety Saturday enforcement. We have a large stretch of I-80, approximately 15 miles, numerous State Highways, and miles of connector roadways.

We are partnering with the Nebraska State Patrol on their Safety Saturday event on July 10 and August 21, 2010

We have always taken a pro active approach by educating our youth and adults on the dangers of drinking and driving. Sarpy County has unfortunately experienced numerous problems with the continuing problem, including numerous traffic fatalities involving impaired drivers. Last year, 2009, numerous alcohol related calls for service and accidents were recorded on that weekend.

Since January 1, 2010 the Sarpy County Jail has tested over 100 people for alcohol involved driving arrests.

2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective

The Sarpy County Sheriff Department is planning to partner with the Nebraska State Patrol on their Safety Saturday scheduled events on July 10 and August 21. We will be conducting saturation patrols with a cooperative effort with The Nebraska State Patrol for all traffic enforcement including DWI

3. Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity

We plan to target areas with aggressive patrol on both dates and will be in cooperation with the Nebraska State Patrol, working all types of traffic enforcement, i.e., DWI, speed, etc.

4. Budget Selective Overtime :

$\$24.009 \times 1.5 = \$42.014 \times 8 \text{ hours} = \$336.11 \times 5 \text{ deputies} \times \text{two days of enforcement} =$



Total Request: \$3131.52

5. Impact Evaluation: We are expecting to reduce the number of impaired drivers on the streets and highways of Sarpy County. We will provide summary activity report at the completion of project if approved.

This is also joint operation with the Nebraska State Patrol for the holiday enforcement.



Re: Safety Saturday Selective Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant between the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety and the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office

On June 15, 2010, the County Board will be asked to ratify the Safety Saturday Selective Overtime Enforcement Application for the attached mini-grant with the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety (NOHS) and the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office (SCSO). The grant was applied for and submitted by the SCSO on May 31, 2010.
