## **1. Baseline Information:**

The Sarpy County Sheriff Department is applying for the "You Drink & Drive, you lose" grant to continue to aggressively combat the DWI situation and the continuing problem with impaired drivers. Sarpy County has unfortunately experienced numerous motor vehicle accidents as a result of alcohol impaired drivers. With a large stretch of I-80, 15 miles and numerous State Highways, and miles and miles of connector roadways, the traffic and accidents are continual. We would like to target areas, along major highways, with the intent of removing impaired drivers from the roadways, and ultimately saving lives and preventing injuries. We have taken a Pro Active education approach to the situation, by educating our youth and schools, as well as numerous businesses and Offutt Air Force Base with the tragedy's and penalties associated with Alcohol impairment.

Since January 1, the Sarpy County Jail has tested over 500 people for alcohol involved driving arrests.

## **2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective:**

The Sarpy County Sheriff is planning a DWI Enforcement program that will hopefully reduce injuries by removing impaired drivers from the streets before an accident occurs. We plan to pursue alcohol impaired drivers by utilizing aggressive patrol in target areas. We currently have investigated over 35 alcohol related crashes since January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 and have made over 192 alcohol related arrests in the same time frame.

### 3. Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity:

We plan to target areas operating our enforcement during the hours of 9 P.M. to 3 A.M., On Friday and Saturday nights, from August 20 thru September 6 plus Sunday September 5 and Labor Day, September 6, 2010. We also plan to concentrate on the Sunday, September 5 and Labor Day as the end of the summer celebration time. Saturday September 5, we will be cosponsoring a DWI check point with the Nebraska State Patrol, Douglas County Sheriff and LaVista Police Department.

### 4. Selective Overtime Budget:

Our Plan is to provide 5 deputies and one Sgt. For six hours each day listed above for DWI patrols. Our budget is as follows:

Five officers, for six hours each day, 7 days of enforcement. Hourly overtime rate is \$42.854 per hour, times 6 hours, times 7 days of activity= \$8999.34. Plus Social Security (SSN) \$688.45. Retirement \$787.44 **Total \$10,475.23**

One Sergeant, for six hours each days 7 days of enforcement. Hourly overtime rate is \$51.99 per hour, times 6 hours, times 7 days of activity= \$2183.58. Plus SSN \$167.04, Retirement \$191.06 **Total \$2541.68**

One Lieutenant for six hours, 2 days of enforcement. Hourly overtime rate is \$58.326 per hour. Plus SSN, \$53.54, retirement \$61.24. **Total \$814.69**

One Booking Clerk, for six hours each day, 7 days of enforcement. Hourly overtime rate is \$29.636 per hour, times 7 days of activity=\$1244.71. Plus SSN \$93.69 and Retirement \$84.02 **Total \$1422.42**

Phase two of our plan is a multi agency DWI checkpoint for September 4, 2010 We will be cooperating with NSP, Douglas County Sheriff, and LaVista PD on this project. The following manpower is needed for that day.

Six deputies, for six hours on September 4, 2010 Hourly rate is \$42.854 per hour, times six hours,=\$1542.74 plus SSN \$118.02, and Retirement \$134.99 **Total \$1795.75**

One Sergeant, for six hours on September 4, 2010. Hourly rate is \$51.99 per hour, times six hours=\$311.94 plus SSN \$23.86 and retirement \$27.30. **Total \$363.10**

One Lieutenant for six hours on September 4, 2010. Hourly rate is \$58.326 per hour, times six hours=\$349.96 plus SSN \$26.77 and retirement \$30.62 **Total \$407.35**

Two staff supports personnel for six hours on September 4, 2010. Hourly rate, \$30.134, times six hours=\$361.61 plus SSN \$27.66 plus retirement \$24.41 **Total \$413.68**

Phase three is to provide extra DWI patrols on Labor Day, the unofficial last day of summer.

Five Deputies, for six hours, holiday pay, Labor Day, hourly rate \$71.423 per hour, times six hours=\$2142.69 plus SSN \$163.92 and retirement \$187.49 **Total \$2494.10**

One Sergeant, for six hours, holiday pay, Labor Day, hourly rate \$86.65 per hour, times six hours=\$519.90 plus SSN \$39.77 and retirement \$45.49 **Total \$605.16**

**Grand Total requested: \$21,333.16**

**5. Impact Evaluation:**

We are greatly expecting to reduce the number of impaired drivers on the Streets and highways of Sarpy County. We will provide summary activity report at completion of project.
