**RESOLUTION DECLARING VEHICLES SURPLUS PROPERTY**  
**AND THE TRANSFER OF TWO SHERIFF'S TOW LOT VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 1997), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 1997), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Board approved a Vehicle Acquisition and Disbursement Policy on January 13, 1998 governing in part the disposal and transfer of surplus vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the following vehicles have been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County:

1. 2003 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN # 2FAFP71W13X115185 - Sheriff's Juvenile Justice Division
2. 2003 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN # 2FAHP71W13X199663 - Sheriff's Administrative Division
3. 2002 Dodge Stratus, VIN # 1B3EL46R82M129590 - Sheriff's Warrants Division

WHEREAS, the following Sheriff's Tow Lot vehicles are approved for department transfer:

1. 2003 Ford Explorer, VIN # 1FMZU73K63ZA26938 to the Sheriff's Juvenile Justice Division.
2. 2006 Chrysler 300, VIN # 2C3KA63H66H153131 to the Sheriff's Warrants Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that aforementioned vehicles are hereby declared to be surplus property and authorizes the Purchasing Department to dispose of the vehicles in the best interest of Sarpy County; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that aforementioned Sheriff's Tow Lot vehicles are authorized for transfer to the Sheriff's Juvenile Justice and Warrants Divisions.

Per Sarpy County Resolution "Approving Vehicle Acquisition & Disbursement Policy", January 13, 1998, attached is Fleet Services recommendations for disposal of the vehicles.

The Sheriff's Juvenile Justice Division is requesting that Unit S997, 2003 Ford Crown Vic, VIN # 2FAFP71W13X115185, be declared surplus property. This vehicle's mileage is 137,821. The wear and tear on this vehicle is evident and is not cost effective to maintain. It is recommended by Pat Clarke, Fleet Service, that this Crown Vic be sold at the next Sheriff's auction. This vehicle has been replaced by a 2003 Ford Explorer, VIN # 1FMZU73K63ZA26938 from the Sheriff's Tow Lot, which was a confiscated vehicle.

The Sheriff's Administrative Division is requesting that a 2003 Ford Crown Vic, VIN # 2FAHP71W13X199663, be declared surplus property. This vehicle's mileage is 113,290. The wear and tear on this vehicle is evident and is not cost effective to maintain. It is recommended by Pat Clarke, Fleet Service, that this Crown Vic be sold at the next Sheriff's auction. This vehicle has been replaced by a 2006 Chrysler 300, VIN # 2C3KA63H66H153131, from the Sheriff's Tow Lot, which was a confiscated vehicle.



recommended by Pat Clarke, Fleet Service, that this Dodge Stratus be sold at the next Sheriff's auction.
