RESOLUTION DECLARING SHERIFF'S OFFICE VEHICLES AS SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 2007), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, on January 13, 1998, the County Board approved a Vehicle Acquisition and Disbursement Policy concerning, in part, the disposal of County vehicles determined by this Board to be surplus property; and,

WHEREAS, the following vehicles are considered obsolete or not usable by the County:

WHEREAS, disposing of the aforementioned vehicles as surplus property is in the best interests of the citizens of Sarpy County.




