RESOLUTION DECLARING SARPY COUNTY SHERIFF'S POLICE DOG AS SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 2007), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Sheriff's Department is in possession of a police dog named Dakota that was donated to that department for their official use; and,

WHEREAS, Dakota has faithfully served the Sarpy County Sheriff's Department, but at an age of seven years, that career is now at an end; and,

WHEREAS, Section 23-3107, R.R.S. 1943 provides that the County Board may dispose of by sale personal property which has been declared by the County Board to be surplus and which is obsolete or not usable by the County; and,

WHEREAS, Dakota is not suitable for sale since because of his specialized training, he can only be properly cared for by an individual with suitable experience with dogs of this nature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners, that Dakota's faithful service is hereby recognized and it is with honor that Dakota is declared as surplus property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Dakota is hereby given to his handler, Deputy Todd Merritt, who is able to provide suitable care for him..


