RESOLUTION DECLARING VEHICLES SURPLUS PROPERTY  
AND THE TRANSFER OF THREE VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 1997), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 1997), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Board approved a Vehicle Acquisition and Disbursement Policy on January 13, 1998 governing in part the disposal and transfer of surplus vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the following vehicles have been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County;

**Ref: Disposal and Transfer Recommendation – Surplus Vehicles**

We have several vehicles that have been declared as surplus. One of these units was replaced with a new vehicle for Investigation. One was not cost effective to repair at this time and will be replaced later when the surplus Sheriff's Road Patrol cars are available. Two vehicles are surplus from Fleet Service. Two vehicles are being replaced with two newer/better vehicles from the Tow lot. One vehicle will be declared surplus now and replaced with a different larger vehicle purchased from the City of Bellevue.

I have evaluated the vehicles and recommend the following:

The surplus car from Sheriff Investigation is to be reassigned to the Fleet Services to replace older vehicle.
