WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-104 (Reissue 2007), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-103 (Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board of Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-172 (Reissue 2007), the County has adopted codes relating to building, repair, maintenance or use of various structures, as well as a fee schedule to be used for the issuance of building and grading permits pursuant to said codes; and,

WHEREAS, the Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District plans to construct a trail between Highway 50 and Chalco Hills Recreation Area (Mopac Trail project) and does not wish to expend public funds for the payment of the grading permit fee. Said permit fee for the project is approximately \$1,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SARPY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT the permit fee for the Mopac Trail project of the Papio-Missouri Resources District, is hereby waived.
