WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, a grant is available to the Sarpy County Sheriff's Department through PRIDE-Omaha; and,

WHEREAS, the grant awards reimbursement to Sarpy County for conducting MIP Party Patrols; and,


WHEREAS, Sarpy County is committed to and supports the Grant with PRIDE-Omaha to conduct MIP Party Patrols; and,

Dear Lt. Zeeb:

Thank you and the Sarpy County Sheriff's Department for agreeing to conduct four (4) MIP Party Patrols between now and June 1, 2012, and to implement the TRACE program between now and April 30, 2012 in ~~Cass~~ Sarpy County. As per our telephone conversations, I have attached two simple Memoranda of Agreement (MOA's) that we need to have signed – one for the Party Patrols and one for the TRACE program. Please have Sheriff Jeff Davis, or a designated representative, sign both MOA's and return to me at your earliest convenience.

You will then be authorized to conduct the four Party Patrols any time at your discretion between now and June 1, 2012, to be reimbursed by PRIDE-Omaha, Inc. for up to \$1,660. You will also be authorized to spend up to an additional \$1,000 to implement the TRACE (Target Responsibility for Alcohol Connected Emergencies) program any time between now and April 30, 2012.

Enclosed please find two packets of information. One packet explains the MIP Party Patrols and has four sets of updated reporting forms. The other packet explains the TRACE implementation and contains two updated TRACE reporting forms. All forms are available electronically. Please contact me.

Please complete the appropriate forms and either mail them to PRIDE at 6143 Whitmore St., Omaha, NE 68152 or fax both to: 402-397-9924. You should receive a check within one week to fourteen days.

Whenever possible, we hope that you will try to find the person or persons that provided the alcohol to minors. If you provide that person's name and court date to us, PRIDE will attempt to judiciously follow up with prosecutors and judges so that, if convicted, that person will face sentencings that will act as a deterrent to others. It is our hope that the general public will eventually get the message that providing alcohol to minors is a serious offense and is a crime not worth committing. We will work in a spirit of cooperation with the justice system and will not be adversarial.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Between

Sarpy County Sheriff Department

and

PRIDE-OMAHA, Inc.

MIP Party Patrols


The Sarpy County Sheriff Department and Pride-Omaha, Inc. agree to the following responsibilities relating to the implementation of the LiveWise MIP (Minor in Possession) Party Patrol grant.

1. The term of this Agreement shall be for the period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.
2. For purposes of completing the MIP Party Patrols, the Sarpy County Sheriff Department will be responsible for a minimum of 4 enforcement operations during the agreement period. These operations will be conducted in ~~Omaha~~, Nebraska.

3. PRIDE-Omaha, Inc. will reimburse up to \$1,660 to the Sarpy County Sheriff Department for the operational cost of conducting MIP Party Patrol operations during the period beginning July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2012. Reimbursement will be made for overtime expenses.
4. Officers will complete the supplied, required reporting forms on each operation in its entirety, providing general information on numbers of minors and names of adults arrested and any retailers in violation. Court dates and times will also be noted. PRIDE-Omaha, Inc. will provide party patrol summary and reimbursement request forms. One summary form and one reimbursement form is to be completed by Sarpy County Sheriff Department for each day of operations conducted. The two completed forms are to be returned to PRIDE-Omaha, Inc. within 10 days of that operation. The goal is that a maximum of four MIP Party Patrol operations be conducted by Sarpy County Sheriff Department, as far as is reasonable, during the contract period.

PRIDE-Omaha, Inc., in conjunction with the LiveWise Coalition, is helping to fund and coordinate MIP (Minors in Possession of Alcohol) Party Patrols with law enforcement agencies in Cass, Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy and Washington Counties in Nebraska in order to prevent underage alcohol use.

Alcohol is the number one cause of preventable death and injury among adolescents in Nebraska. Research indicates that enforcement of state statutes regarding alcohol and minors is a critical component for communities that are working to reduce underage consumption of alcohol.

Under this grant, law enforcement agencies in the above counties, as well as the Nebraska State Patrol, randomly conduct special selective enforcement efforts. These patrols are devoted to investigating underage drinking activity, including teen drinking parties. The patrols can also check areas where teen drinkers frequent. They are also able to respond to citizen complaints.

Follow-up investigations often include determining who supplied the minors with the alcohol. When citations for procuring alcohol for minors are issued, PRIDE-Omaha, Inc. then works with communities to follow these cases through the adjudication process, urging the courts to hold those convicted of these crimes accountable. By drawing attention to the fact that providing alcohol to minors is a serious violation of law that can result in jail sentences, the coalition hopes to prevent other adults from committing the same crime.

Funding for the MIP Party Patrols is supported in part by the LiveWise Coalition and Region 6 Behavioral Healthcare through the Substance Abuse Block Grant of the Department of Health and Human Services System.

PRIDE-Omaha, Inc. has been working with local law enforcement agencies on MIP Party Patrols since 1993. The current grant funding period of the LiveWise Coalition grant is from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. The program is coordinated by Susie Dugan, Project Manager for PRIDE-Omaha, Inc. Ms. Dugan has over thirty-two years of experience in the drug prevention profession.
