WHEREAS, bids for the Single Seal Armor Coat, Project C-77 (11-08) have been solicited, made, opened and reviewed pursuant to applicable Nebraska State Statutes; and,

WHEREAS, based on those proceedings, and after a public hearing, this Board has duly deliberated and considered the bid received; and,

WHEREAS, permission to re-solicit bids has been requested; and,



## Memo

Re: Single Seal Armor Coat

On August 30, 2011 one (1) bid was opened for the Single Seal Armor Coat for Fairview Road (0.50 Miles West of Highway 6 to Railroad Tracts) 57<sup>th</sup> & LaPlatte Road (0.40 Miles North to Zwiebel Creek), Project C-77 (11-08) for the Public Works Department. The Engineer's Estimate for the project is \$20,928.00; however the base bid received was \$51,759.60. County staff contacted the vendors and determined that contractors in our area do not have the capacity to complete this project this year, which increased the unit prices. The bid was also significantly higher than the Engineer's Estimate due to over specifying the base stabilization part of the project.

County staff is requesting this project be rebid with a reduction of the scope of work that better fits project expectations along with expanding the contractor list to Lincoln, which is a reasonable distance for project contractors. Contractors will also have the option to complete the project either this fall or next spring.

Therefore, it is requested that all bids be rejected along with permission to rebid the project. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me at [bcunard@sarpy.com](mailto:bcunard@sarpy.com).
