WHEREAS, Sarpy County Sheriff Jeff Davis signed the award on September 29, 2011; and,


WHEREAS, Sarpy County is committed to and supports funding for the grant referenced in the attached memo; and;

1. Baseline Information

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is applying for a "Selective Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant" in order to assist in overtime costs associated with the participation in a DUI Enforcement checkpoint. The DUI checkpoint will be held on Friday, October 28th, 2011 with the LaVista Police Department and other local Law Enforcement agencies. The last DUI Enforcement checkpoint that the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office participated in with LaVista PD was very successful and productive.

2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office, along with several other local Law Enforcement agencies, plans to participate in the DUI Enforcement checkpoint with the LaVista PD on Friday, October 28th, 2011. The overall objective of this enforcement activity is to ensure that vehicles are being operated with all safety equipment and proper documentation, but more importantly, to ensure that impaired drivers are taken off of the roadways of Sarpy County.

3. Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office, LaVista PD, and other local Law Enforcement agencies plan on conducting a DUI checkpoint in the LaVista area on the night of Friday, October 28th, 2011. The overall enforcement activity involved with this checkpoint will be to ensure that all vehicles checked are using all safety equipment required, they have the required documentation in their vehicles, and more importantly, any impaired drivers will be arrested and removed from the roadways of Sarpy County Nebraska.

4. Selective Overtime Budget

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office would like to provide four (4) deputies for six (6) hours for this DUI checkpoint. We would also like to provide one (1) Booking Clerk for six (6) hours for this enforcement activity. The following overtime costs would be as follows:

Four (4) Deputies overtime for six (6) hours = \$1,077.77 + Social Security \$82.45 + Retirement \$94.31 = \$1,254.53

One (1) booking Clerk overtime for six (6) hours = \$183.16 + Social Security \$14.01 + Retirement \$12.36 = \$209.52

Total = \$1,464.05

5. Impact Evaluation

Through the use of this "Selective Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant", the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is expecting to reduce the number of alcohol/drug related impaired driver's that operate on the roadways of Sarpy County on the night of Friday, October 28th, 2011. As always, our goal is to reduce the number of accidents that impaired driver's cause on our roadways.
