RESOLUTION INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE 2012 FY FG-JUVENILE PRE-TRIAL
ASSESSMENT FUND BUDGET

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 2007), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, due to the processing of a voided check from a previous fiscal year, additional appropriations are needed for the continued operation of the FG-Juvenile Pre-Trial Assessment fund after the adoption of the 2012 fiscal year budget; and,

WHEREAS, Section 13-511 provides that the previously adopted budget may be supplemented after conducting a public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners, that the following fund is hereby increased:

FG-Juvenile Pre-Trial Assessment fund budget is hereby increased by \$320 from \$0 to \$320. The source of revenue to cover the increase in budgeted expenditures will be cash on hand in the FG-Juvenile Pre-Trial Assessment fund.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with applicable law on the 8th day of May, 2012.



Re: Additional Appropriations for FG-Juvenile Pre-Trial Assessment fund


