

## **1. Baseline Information**

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is applying for the May 21<sup>st</sup> to June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2012 "Click-It or Ticket" Mobilization grant to continue aggressive enforcement of motorists violating the State of Nebraska's seat belt law and child restraint law. Sarpy County continues to experience problems with motorists not using seat belts or child restraints, and recent accidents in Sarpy County revealed that some of our injured motorists were not using seat belts at the time of their motor vehicle accidents. For instance just recently we experienced a roll-over accident where the female driver was ejected. She was not wearing a seat belt and experienced multiple rib fractures and other internal injuries, but she did survive the accident.

## **2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective**

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is planning a "Click It or Ticket" program of both survey work and aggressive enforcement patrols with zero tolerance on seat belt and child restraint violations. With strict enforcement of seat belt and child restraint violations, the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office hopes to reduce serious motor vehicle accidents and heighten the public's awareness of safety when driving on the roadways of Sarpy County Nebraska.

### **3. Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity**

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office plans to target areas throughout our county at different periods of the day. We will be conducting all activity beginning May 21st, 2012 until June 3rd, 2012 for "Click It or Ticket". And as always, we will be cooperating with surrounding agencies in the Metro Omaha metro area for strict enforcement of all law violations, specifically over the Memorial Day Holiday weekend.

### **4. Selective Overtime Budget**

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is planning to provide two (2) deputies for four (4) hours each day. This would be a total of fourteen (14) days of enforcement with 112 hours of overtime manpower:

Two (2) deputies x \$44.907 x 4 hours = \$179.63 x 13 days = \$2,335.19 x 2 deputies = \$4,670.38 + Social Security \$403.09 and + retirement \$461.05 + Holiday overtime rate of \$598.76

Holiday overtime rate (Memorial Day) \$74.845 x 4 hours = \$299.38 x 2 deputies = \$598.76

**Total = \$6,133.28**


