**RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR HEARING PROTESTS**  
**REGARDING ASSESSED VALUES**

WHEREAS, by virtue of Neb. Rev. Stat. §77-1501 (Reissue 2009) the County Board of Equalization is required to fairly and impartially equalize the values of all items of real property in the county so that all real property is assessed uniformly and proportionately; and,

WHEREAS, the County Board of Equalization may meet between June 1 and July 25 of any year to consider and correct the assessment of property which has been undervalued, overvalued, or omitted pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §77-1504 (Reissue 2009); and,

WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. §77-1502 (Reissue 2009) allows the County Board of Equalization to extend the deadline for hearing protests from July 25 to August 10; and,

WHEREAS, by extending said deadline, the County Board of Equalization waives any right to petition for an adjustment to a class or sub-class of property, but that none is needed for the current year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sarpy County Board of Equalization that the deadline for hearing protests of assessed value is hereby extended from July 25 to August 10, said extension being for the current year only.

The above and foregoing Resolution was duly approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with applicable law on this \_\_\_\_ day of July, 2012.
