WHEREAS, Sarpy County is committed to and supports submission of the grant referenced in the attached memo; and;



On August 7, 2012 the County Board will be asked to ratify the application for the Preliminary Breath Tester (PBT) Mini- Grant with the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety (NOHS) and the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office (SCSO). The applicant must submit the following supporting documentation with this application:


- 1) a copy of your department's current employee safety belt policy; and,
