RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHAIRMAN TO SIGN ADDENDUM TO
JAIL FOOD SERVICES AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 2007), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,


WHEREAS, Sarpy County (hereinafter "County") and DVAL Enterprises, Inc. (hereinafter "DVAL"), have entered into agreements dated September 1, 1992, as amended on December 7, 1993, October 18, 1994, April 2, 1996, December 10, 1996, March 16, 1999, January 25, 2002, November 23, 2004, January 8, 2008, and May 1, 2012 for the purpose of operating jail food service facilities; and,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners, that the Sarpy County Jail and the Sarpy County Juvenile Justice Center will receive food service by DVAL until December 31, 2012 and that the Agreement also continues to provide that the requirements for medically-prescribed and religious diets will be strictly adhered to.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the rate per meal per person for the Juvenile Justice Center shall be: breakfast - \$1.74; lunch - \$2.05; dinner - \$3.60; and a transportation fee of \$52.50 per day shall be paid for delivery of meals to the Juvenile Justice Center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of this Board is authorized to sign the attached Addendum modifying delivery services and fees the Juvenile Justice Center food service contract.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with applicable law on the 25th day of September, 2012.

ADDENDUM TO JAIL FOOD SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Addendum is made between Sarpy County (hereinafter "County") and DVAL Enterprises, Inc. (hereinafter "DVAL") to a certain Contract between said parties dated September 1, 1992.

Said Agreement is hereby modified and amended as followed:

1. The rate per meal per person for the Juvenile Justice Center shall be: breakfast - \$1.74; lunch - \$2.05; and, dinner - \$3.60 and the transportation fee remaining unchanged at \$52.50 per day for delivery of meals to the Juvenile Justice Center.
2. The Juvenile Justice Center Food Service shall be extended until December 31, 2012 and notice of termination of the Juvenile Justice Center Food Service on September 25, 2012 is hereby given.
3. That the remaining provisions of the September 1, 1992 Agreement, as previously amended on December 7, 1993, October 18, 1994, April 2, 1996, December 10, 1996, March 16, 1999, January 25, 2002, December 10, 2002, November 23, 2004, January 8, 2008, and May 1, 2012 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified herein.
4. That the provision of food services will in all respects comply with Nebraska Jail Standards Title 81, Chapter 11, "Standards for Jail Facilities - Food Services" (Reissue 1994), including the requirements pertaining to medically-prescribed diets and religious diets.

Re: JJC Food Service

On September 25, 2012 the County Board will be requested to approve the attached resolution authorizing the chairman to sign the addendum to remove the Juvenile Justice Center from the Jail Food Service Agreement. In order to obtain new State eligibility reimbursement the County must clarify the portions of food currently being served to juveniles. Jail food service prices have not increased for the past twenty (20) years and therefore the addendum keeps the jail food service contract in place.

Along with approving the addendum, the Board is also requested to approve Permission to Solicit Bids for Juvenile Justice Food Service. The new agreement will begin January 1, 2013.
