WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 2007), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,


WHEREAS, the Department of Veterans Affairs has conducted a Programmatic Environmental Assessment for a proposed National Cemetery to serve the Metro-Omaha area; and,

WHEREAS, it has been proven that the Metro-Omaha area has a need for additional cemetery capacity to improve access to Veterans and their families; and,

WHEREAS, the Preferred Action Alternative site is in Sarpy County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners do here by support the construction of a National Cemetery in Sarpy County to better serve the burial needs of our Veterans and their families in the Metro-Omaha area.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with applicable law on the 16th day of October, 2012.


