WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 1997), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Board approved a Vehicle Acquisition and Disbursement Policy on January 13, 1998 governing in part the disposal and transfer of surplus vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the following vehicles have been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County:

- Unit 104 - 2002 Dodge Ram - VIN: 3B7KF23Z62M281492, miles 162,000 - Public Works Department.
- Unit 187 - 2004 Ford Crown Vic - VIN: 2FAFP71WX4X167657, miles 136,919 - Public Works Department and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that the aforementioned vehicles are hereby declared to be surplus property and authorizes the Purchasing Department to dispose of the vehicles in the best interest of Sarpy County.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with applicable law on the 20th day of November, 2012.
