

Re: Selective Alcohol Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant Award for the National "You Drink and Drive, You Lose" campaign.

On December 11, 2012, the County Board will be asked to ratify the submission and award for the Selective Alcohol Overtime Enforcement grant with the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety (NOHS) and the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office (SCSO). The grant was applied for and submitted by the SCSO.

The grant awards up to \$7,500 in overtime reimbursement to the SCSO from December 14, 2012 – January 1, 2013. The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office will aggressively pursue drivers who are impaired, targeting specific roadways where serious injury and fatality accidents have occurred. The objective will be to saturate main roadways with extra deputies for the purpose of detecting alcohol impaired drivers.



SUBJECT: "Click It or Ticket" Safety Belt Mobilization  
"You Drink & Drive. You Lose." Impaired Driving Crackdown

The increasing number of traffic deaths this year points out the need to continue to emphasize compliance with Nebraska's seat belt law and the proactive enforcement of Nebraska's impaired driving laws. At the current rate, we would finish 2012 with the highest number of traffic deaths in the past five years.

As of October for example, the lack of seat belt law compliance has resulted in 55 rollover fatalities, with only four of those wearing seat belts at the time of the crash. In fact, all but four of those killed were either partially or fully ejected from the vehicle.

So far this year, we have three more alcohol-related fatalities than the 51 we recorded for all of 2011. In addition, we have recorded two more teen alcohol-related fatalities than occurred for all of last year.

Of the 54 passenger vehicle fatalities between 6:00 pm and 6:00 am, only five (9%) were wearing belts. That compares to the 60 passenger vehicle fatalities between 6:00 am and 6:00 pm where 23 (38%) were wearing belts. In an effort to target resources appropriately, we are requiring that 40% of overtime Click It or Ticket enforcement be directed to 6:00 pm to 6:00 am time period.

Your continued help is needed. Enforcement for the statewide **"Click It or Ticket"** mobilization will take place **November 19 -25, 2012**. Enforcement for the national **"You Drink & Drive. You Lose."** Crackdown will take place **December 14, 2012 - January 1, 2013**. Agencies in all 93 counties are eligible to apply for overtime enforcement grant funding assistance. The mini-grant applications are included in this packet and should be submitted to our office a minimum of 30 days prior to the first date of enforcement. **Requests for funding assistance must be approved before overtime activity takes place.**

**Want to participate without funding assistance?** Everyone is urged to participate as part of your routine enforcement during this time period. If your agency will be participating without overtime funding assistance simply forward an e-mail to [becky.stinson@nebraska.gov](mailto:becky.stinson@nebraska.gov) stating your intent to participate.



## **1. Baseline Information**

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is applying for a "Selective Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant" for the December 14, 2012 through January 1, 2013 "You Drink & Drive, You Lose" Crackdown. The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office would like to participate in this crackdown as, during this holiday time, our community has experienced several serious and fatal motor vehicle accidents in previous years. These serious and fatal motor vehicle accidents have occurred both during the daytime, as well as night, and have mainly occurred on the major roadways in Sarpy County. Unfortunately, many of the night time serious motor vehicle accidents involved intoxicated drivers.

## **2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective**

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office believes that with the assistance from your office, we can put more deputies on the roadways during this holiday season and significantly reduce the number of serious and fatal motor vehicle accidents, by targeting speeders, traffic violators, and most importantly, intoxicated drivers. By targeting the roadways and traffic violation, the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office believes we can significantly reduce the number of serious motor vehicle accidents in Sarpy County Nebraska.

## **3. Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity**

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office will target the main roadways in Sarpy County to include Highway 75, Highway 370, Highway 50, and Highway 6/31. We will have Two (2) extra deputies patrol the evening and late night hours in order to cover the hours when liquor establishments are closing. Our deputies will focus their enforcement actions on general traffic

violations such as speeding, and other infractions, with a main focus on removing intoxicated drivers off of the roadways of Sarpy County Nebraska. We will also have one (1) extra jail deputy, and one (1) extra booking clerk, to handle the increase in persons arrested and placed into the Sarpy County Jail.

#### 4. Selective Overtime Budget

Three (3) deputies, and one (1) Booking Clerk for six (6) hours on each of the eleven (11) days: December 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 28, 29, 30, 31-2012, and January 1, 2013.

Three (3) Deputies overtime for six (6) hours on 10 regular days = \$8,366.22 + Social Security \$640.02 + Retirement \$732.04 = \$9,738.28

Three (3) Deputies holiday overtime for six (6) hours on New Year's Day = \$1,394.37 + Social Security \$106.67 + Retirement \$1623.05

One (1) Booking Clerk overtime for six (6) hours on 10 regular days = \$1,973.46 + Social Security \$150.97 + Retirement \$133.21 = \$2,257.64

One (1) Booking Clerk holiday overtime for six (6) hours on New Year's Day = \$328.91 + Social Security \$25.16 + Retirement \$22.20 = \$376.27

**Grand Total = \$12,062.96 + \$922.82 (SSN) + \$1,009.46 (RET) = \$13,995.24**

#### 5. Impact Evaluation

Through the use of this "Selective Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant", the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is expecting to reduce the number of alcohol/drug related impaired driver's that operate on the roadways of Sarpy County. As always, our goal is to reduce the number of serious and fatal accidents that impaired driver's cause on our roadways.
