RESOLUTION DECLARING SHERIFF AND PUBLIC WORKS VEHICLES SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 2007), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Board approved a Vehicle Acquisition and Disbursement Policy on January 13, 1998 governing in part the disposal and transfer of surplus vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the following vehicles have been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County:

1. 1993 Ford Explorer, VIN #1FMDU34X2PUB10500 - Public Works
2. 2007 Ford Crown Vic, VIN # 2FAFP71W77X146639 - Sheriff's Road Patrol

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that aforementioned vehicles are hereby declared to be surplus property and authorizes the Purchasing Department to dispose of the vehicles in the best interest of Sarpy County.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with applicable law on the 28th day of February, 2012.



Per Sarpy County Resolution "Approving Vehicle Acquisition & Disbursement Policy", January 13, 1998, attached is Fleet Services recommendations for disposal of the vehicles.

Public Works is requesting that a 1993 Ford Explorer, VIN #1FMDU34X2PUB10500, be declared surplus property. This vehicle's mileage is 135,664. The wear and tear on this vehicle is evident and is not cost effective to maintain. It is recommended by Pat Clarke, Fleet Service, that this Explorer be sold at the next Sheriff's auction. This vehicle is in the process of being replaced with a new vehicle.

The Sheriff's Road Patrol is requesting that the 2007 Ford Crown Vic, VIN # 2FAFP71W77X146639, be declared surplus property. This vehicle's mileage is 129,111. The wear and tear on this vehicle is evident and is not cost effective to maintain. It is recommended by Pat Clarke, Fleet Service, that this Crown Vic be sold at the next Sheriff Impound Lot auction. This vehicle has been replaced with a new vehicle late last year.

It is recommended that the attached Resolution, declaring the specified County vehicles surplus property, be signed.
