

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA

RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION 2004-095

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-104 (Reissue 2007), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-103 (Reissue 2007), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. Sect. 39-1816 (Reissue 2008), the County Board may prohibit or restrict parking of motor vehicles on the right-of-way of county roads and may erect signs giving notice of no parking or restricted parking; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. Sect. 60-680 (Reissue 2010), the County Board may regulate stopping, standing or parking with respect to roads under its jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2004-095, filed at Commissioners Book 21, Page 318, ("Rsln. No. 2004-095"), approved the placement of "No Parking" signs along the west side of Trumble Avenue from Olney Street to a point 225' south; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2012-16, signed on January 24, 2012 ("Rsln. No. 2012-16"), approved the placement of "No Parking" signs along the west side of Trumble Avenue from Olney Street south to a point 125' +/- ; and,

WHEREAS, Rsln. Nos. 2004-095 and 2012-16 essentially contradict each other in that Rsln. No. 2004-095 requires the "No Parking" restriction for 225 feet along Trumble Avenue and Rsln. No. 2012-16 requires the "No Parking" restriction for 125 feet along Trumble Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of Sarpy County to rescind one of the above resolutions so that the two actions of the County Board are not contradictory to each other, and the Public Works Department requests that the County Board rescind Rsln. No. 2004-095.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SARPY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that this Board hereby rescinds Resolution No. 2004-095 as it is in the best interests of the County.


